Regular Council Meeting
Minutes of Aug. 3, 2026
6:30 pm at City Hall

- **Call to Order** Pursuant to notice published on the city website: www.cityofpaisley.net, and notice published at the Paisley Post office and given to members of the Council, the Regular Council Meeting of the City of Paisley was held on Aug. 3, 2026, at Paisley City Hall. Paisley Mayor Keith Harra called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Council members in attendance were Len Babb III, and Trina Negus. Others in attendance were Lori Mayea, Eugene Beachler, Eric Hill, Earl Faunce, Amy Davis and Shelia Babb, recording minutes.
- **Appointing new council member: Keith** Harra entertains motions to accept Amy Davis as new council member taking Craig Delarm's spot, Len Babb III makes a motion to accept Amy Davis as new council member, Trina Negus 2nds the motion. Keith Harra then swears Amy Davis into position. Voting Aye: Keith Harra, Len Babb III, and Trina Negus. Voting nay: none, motion carries.
- **Consent Calendar:** Keith Harra entertained a motion to accept the minutes from the July 6th meeting, Len Babb III motions to accept the minutes from the July 6th meeting, Amy Davis 2nds the motion. Voting aye: Keith Harra, Len Babb III, Trina Negus, and Amy Davis. Voting nay: none, motion carries. Amy Davis motions to accept the July Invoices, Len Babb III 2nds the motion. Voting aye: Keith Harra, Len Babb III, Amy Davis, and Trina Negus. Voting nay: none, motion carries.
- **Business:** Eric Hill and Jason White own the 668 Mill st. property and they were wanting a permit to put in a service of electrical boxes and wanted to put in a couple of RVs. Mayor Keith says our city ordinances say only temporally for RV parking. The state requires that the property be at least 2 acres for an RV Park. But for temporary RV sites they can put in a conditional use permit to park an RV while they build a cabin. Eric will fill out necessary permits to continue with the Electrical box. Trina Negus

makes a motion to make 670 Mill st. an actual address, Len Babb III 2nds the motion. Voting aye: Keith Harra, Len Babb III, Amy Davis, and Trina Negus. Voting nay: none, motion carries.

Hwy signs – ODOT needs to go through a process before allowing a no parking sign along highway. Len Babb III says we should scrap the whole idea; it would cost city too much and may hurt the businesses. Enforcement of any signs would be hard with only 8 deputies in the county.

Candidate Filing: Shelia Babb let the council members, whose seats are up at the end of the year know that she has the necessary forms if they want to renew their seats. The deadline is Aug. 25th for appointees and the 18th for elected officials.

Water rates for Businesses: Council is implementing the commercial rate for businesses starting in September. Pioneer Saloon and Paisley Auto and Towing are fine with it.

- **Public Comment:** Earl Faunce was wondering if the monies the city makes on the Mosquito Festival are enough to cover the spraying costs? And Keith Harra said “No” it does not. Brought about questions about whether we should continue with the festival or not. Keith Harra suggested that the city make an advertisement for a Mosquito Festival Committee Head and wants to appoint said person by Oct. 2026. Need to have more accountability. Wanting more kids’ events. Start planning early.
- **Appointing Council President:** Keith Harra made a motion to make Amy Davis as next President of council, Trina Negus 2nd the motion. Voting aye: Keith Harra, Len Babb III, and Trina Negus. Voting nay: none, motion carries.
