NOLSC

The Niagara-on-the-Lake Sailing Club has designed their guest privileges to consider the challenges we face because of our unique location.

NOLSC offers reciprocity of 1-night free stay to other participating clubs around the lake, as follows:

- **RESERVATIONS:** prepaid in advance by Visa or Mastercard and not refundable for your first night second night free with reciprocity – this guarantees accommodation – we cannot guarantee inside dockage.
- **NO RESERVATION:** if you come to NOLSC without a reservation there is no guarantee of accommodation, however, if we can offer you mooring your first night is free with reciprocity and second night is chargeable – we cannot guarantee inside dockage.

Maximum 3-night stay, see Reservation Request Form for pricing.

Check out time is 10:30. We ask visitors do not arrive before 12:00.

The Club staff will allocate mooring locations for visiting boats at their sole discretion.

Visitors are asked to pull up to the gas dock for check in unless they have been given their position prior to arrival.

Unattended visiting yachts, which have not signed in, will be moved to a location suitable to NOLSC as determined by club staff and are subject to a surcharge.

Washing of dishes and/or clothing is not permitted in the NOLSC washrooms.

Visitors will dispose of waste and recycling in the designated areas only (not in washrooms, clubhouses etc.).

Visitors are required to maintain the club washrooms by observing the same standards of cleanliness and good order that they observe at their own clubs.

Visitors are required to assist in energy conservation by reducing the waste of water and power.

Visitors with dogs are to use the north fence line to do their business. It is mandatory that owners pick up after their own dogs and appropriately dispose of waste in proper designated area. Dogs must always be leashed.
