For the Clan MacLeod Series, Great Laker Series

and Brox Company 1812 Series

1 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at <u>https://niagaraonthelakesailingclub.com/racing</u> <u>https://niagaraonthelakesailingclub.com/#racing</u>.
- 2.2 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 71.

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be made at the flagpole nearest the NOLSC riverfront.
- 3.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 The dates of racing are Wednesdays
 - (a) Clan MacLeod Series: June 30 and July 7, 14, 21 and 28;
 - (b) Great Laker Series: August 4, 11, 18 and 24;
 - (c) Brox Company 1812 Series: September 1, 8 and 15.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first class is:
 - (a) 1840 for the Clan MacLeod Series and Great Laker Series;
 - (b) <u>1830 for the Brox Company 1812 Series.</u>
- 4.3 For Sharks:
 - (a) two races are scheduled to be run each day for the Clan MacLeod Series and Great Laker Series;
 - (b) one race is scheduled to be run each day for the Brox 1812 Series.

4.4 No warning signal will be made after 1950.

5 CLASS FLAGS

The Class flags are:

Class	Class Flag
Shark	Numeral pennant 1

6 RACING AREA

The races will be held in the Niagara Race Area.

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The diagrams in SI Addendum A show the courses including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 7.2 <u>No course will be displayed if the course in SI Addendum A will be used. Otherwise no</u> later than the warning signal, the race committee will display the <u>marks in the sequence</u> in which they are to be rounded.course designation:

(a) The Shark course will be displayed on the upper row of the course board;

8 MARKS

- 8.1 Mark 1^a (Sharks) is an orange inflatable tetrahedron.
- 8.2 Mark 2 is an orange inflatable tetrahedron.
- 8.3 The starting and finishing marks are the race committee signal vessel and <u>a red inflatable</u> tetrahedron<u>mark 2</u>.

9 THE START

- 9.1 The starting line is a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the starting mark.
- 9.2 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races.
- 9.3 The race committee intends to start races in the sequence listed in SI 4.1. Failure of the race committee to follow that sequence will not be grounds for redress.
- 9.4 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.

10 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

A course change will be announced verbally on VHF 71. This changes RRS 33.

11 THE FINISH

- 11.1 The finishing line is a staff displaying a blue flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the finishing mark.
- 11.2 If the race committee is absent when a boat finishes she should report her finishing time and her position relative to nearby racing boats to the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

12 TIME LIMITS

- 12.1 The time limit is 2 hours after the class starting time.
- 12.2 Boats failing to finish within 2 hours and 30 minutes after the class starting time will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10.


13 HEARING REQUESTS

- 13.1 The protest time limit is 1200 on the day following the race.

- 13.4 Notices will be posted no later than 72 hours after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.

14 SAFETY REGULATIONS

[DP] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
