A couple of things to talk about, along with a few thank-yous.

It was a decision we made that really depended on the PTA's support, since we asked you to be there a little longer with us. It was definitely worthwhile, so thank you. We also have a couple of celebrations coming up this week. This Friday, we'll be hosting the Senior Walkthrough, a tradition that the high school started several years ago. I heard that the first time we did it, we probably did it the best, so I'm trying to keep that tradition going.

On Friday, graduating seniors return to the elementary school they attended. We usually welcome two busloads of seniors. We print photos of them from their elementary school years, and our current students hold up those pictures as the seniors parade through the hallways. We also have a montage in the cafeteria. Thank you to Mrs. Greco, who put a tremendous amount of effort into gathering old videos and pictures to create it. The seniors also get to visit with some of their former teachers before we head outside to the Big Toy for a group picture.

It's a really exciting day with lots of smiles from both the students and teachers. It's a very special tradition for our graduating seniors, and I'm proud of the work our staff does to make it happen. Thank you as well to the PTA for all of your support.

We also have our Flag Day celebration on Friday afternoon. The Robbins Lane Student Council will be sending out a message encouraging everyone to wear red, white, and blue. This year, we're doing things a little differently.
