**PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:** Ms. Pallos welcomed everyone and addressed rumors and shared her personal. Introduced Ms. Corona, the interim principal. Ms. Corona introduced herself and gave some background information. Ms. Pallos updated everyone on new times for drop off and pick up (8:40-8:50). It's been running smoothly. Carpooling is allowed now in situations where it is necessary. She discussed modifications of some classes due to shift of in person and virtual students. Some overflow classes have been dissolved. Lessons and collaboration remain the same. Technology is being upgraded and it's a work in progress. Professional development is still happening for teachers virtually. Explained that kids are still doing small group work and conferencing through technology. Discussed ways to keep PRIDE going. Assessments are coming up in next few weeks. It's used to drive instructional time with children and it's very helpful for the teachers.

Parents can continue to reach out to her but also Ms. Corona. They will be working together for next few weeks.

Ms. Spiegel showed us what the classrooms look like. She also explained the NWEA test and its importance as a tool to help give teachers a clear picture of where they are academically and what tools they need to progress. This test changes the questions the

kids get based on their previous answers. This is what makes it different from any other test.
