## **2024 MBYC Fall Regatta Report**




Saturday morning checked out SD sail website and it listed conditions 5-9kn, WNW with tide going out. While driving to the club the fog was close to 4 miles inland. Did not look to promising a day. when getting to the club was a little more optimistic as the wind was filled in close to 6kn. At noon the wind was WNW filled in close to 8kn and still foggy. The wind stayed between 6 to 9kn for races 1-3 1/2 and then the fog lifted and the sea breeze veered some more toward the N and the wind picked up close to 11kn for the second half of race 3 and 4. The line and courses were square and it was favorable to get clear of other boats, stay in phase with the shifts and sail the middle for the most part.



Sunday SD sail website had the same conditions as Saturday. driving to the club the fog was close to a mile and a 1/2 inland. More promising! Getting to the club the wind was filled in close to 8-9 kn. The course at noon had 10-12 kn steady. Still foggy but burning off. Line and course square. A little more gusts northly than on Saturday. So, worked the right side of the course, tried to stay in phase with the shifts and had fun in more breezy conditions.
