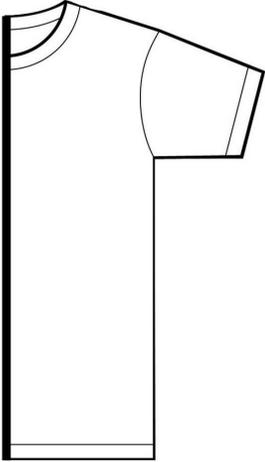




Mustang Masks

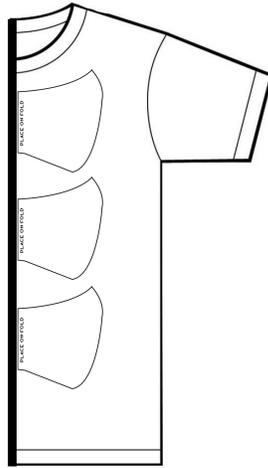
J-Shirt Mask Cutting Instructions

1. Fold Tshirt in half

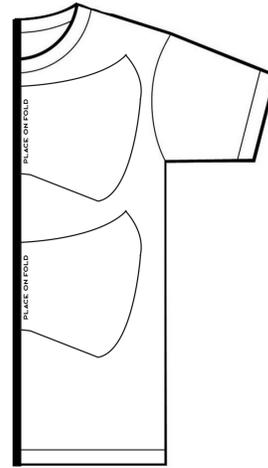


2. Place your pattern piece on the folded edge of the fabric and match the straight line against the fold. This ensures your pieces are completely symmetrical and is often an excellent way to minimize the fabric consumption.

Please Note: The number of patterns you can layout on the T-shirt will vary depending on the pattern size. For example, when cutting a small size pattern, you will be able to cut more pieces than if you are using size large.

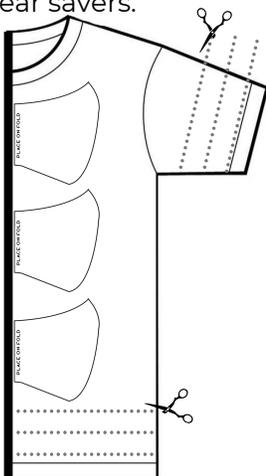


Example: Pattern size small

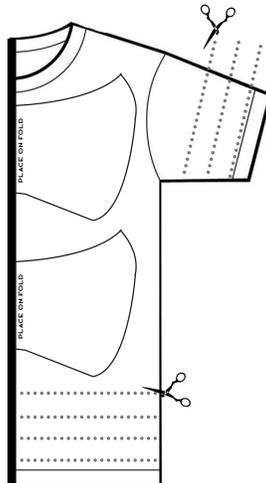


Example: Pattern size large

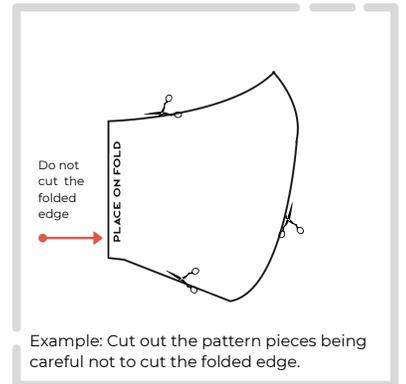
3. Cut out the pattern pieces being careful not to cut the folded edge. (If you accidentally cut on the fold line. It is okay! We can still use the piece to create a mask. Please do not throw it out. We can still use it.) Cut 1 inch strips with the remaining T-shirt fabric. The strips will be used to create T-shirt tie backs and ear savers.



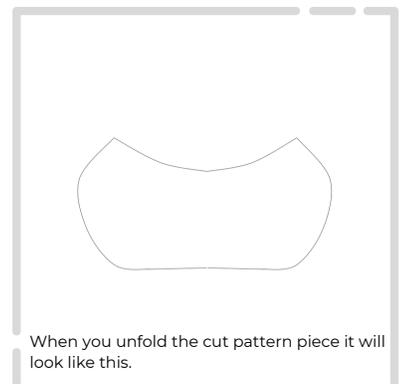
Example: Pattern size small



Example: Pattern size large



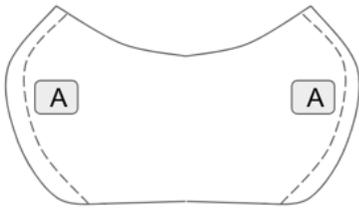
Example: Cut out the pattern pieces being careful not to cut the folded edge.



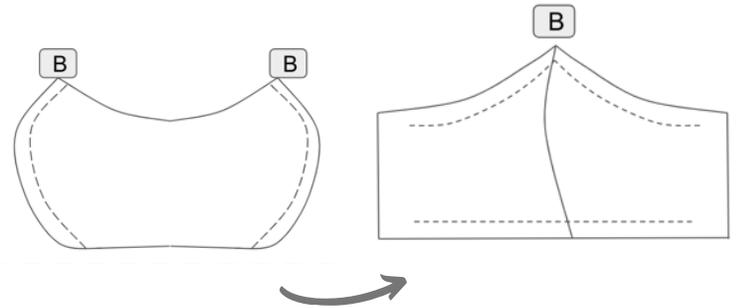
When you unfold the cut pattern piece it will look like this.

T-Shirt Mask Sewing Instructions

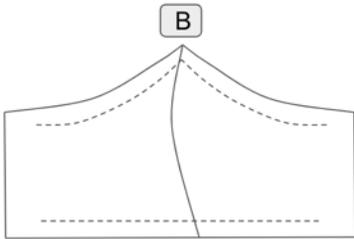
Step 1: Place right sides together. Sew the curved edges. (A)



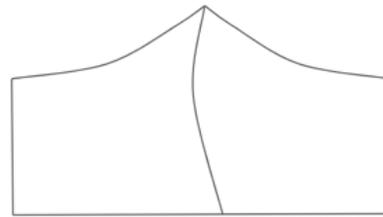
Step 2: Connect both points together. (B)



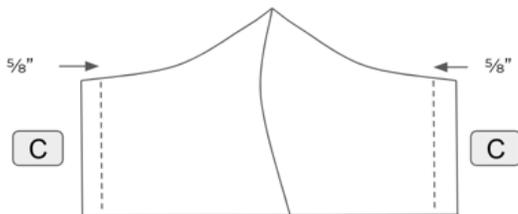
Step 3: Sew right sides together and leave a 1 inch space



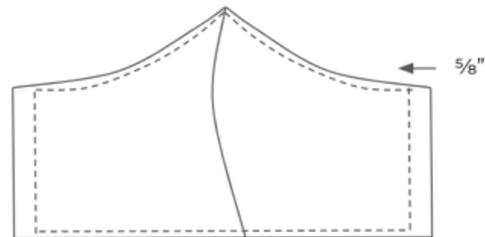
Step 4: Turn right side out and press.



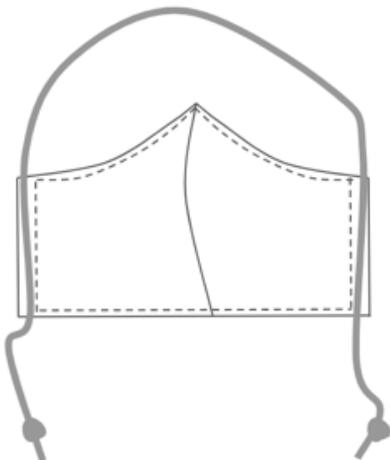
Step 5: Top stitch each side. (C)
Seam Allowance $\frac{5}{8}$ "



Step 6: Top stitch the top and bottom. Be careful not to sew beyond the $\frac{5}{8}$ " space on each side.



Step 5: Pull the tie through the opening on each side.

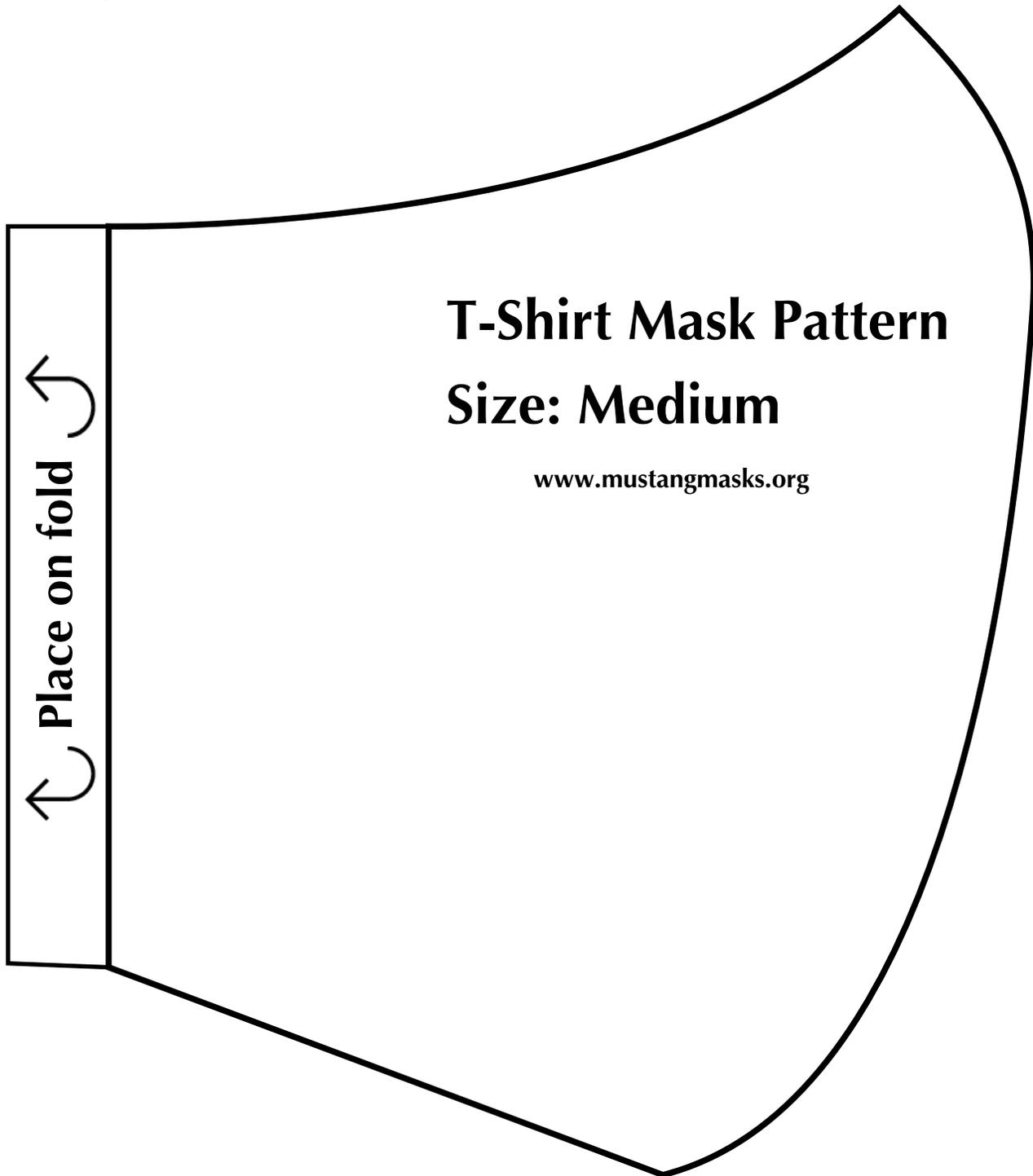


Instructions: Place the edge of the fold line onto the folded edge of the T-shirt or knit fabric. Pin or clip and cut.





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
