Prospectus: Art in the Park: Juried Row – Saturday, June 6th, from 11am-3pm

Application Deadline: May 22, 2026 at 5:00pm

Event Scope –

The City of Statesville Recreation & Economic Vitality and the Iredell Arts Council invite you to apply to showcase your work in the Mooresville Arts Juried Row at the annual **Art in the Park Festival** on **June 6, from 11am-3pm**.

This beloved summer event transforms **Martin Luther King Jr. Park (911 Lakewood Drive, Statesville, North Carolina)** into a vibrant celebration of creativity, featuring multicultural live music, food trucks, local arts organizations, and a wide variety of artwork from across our community.

Mooresville Arts Juried Row -

Mooresville Arts will be facilitating the organization of the fine artists row for this event, and we are looking for fifteen (15) fine artists, ages 18+, including painters, potters, jewelers, fiber artists, woodworkers, photographers, mixed media and more!

This is a JURIED section of the festival, so not all applicants will be accepted. Jurors will review each application, and you will be notified as to whether you are accepted into the festival. Further details will be given to accepted artists closer to the festival date.

The application fee of \$25.00 will serve as the accepted artists' booth fee. This is a non-refundable fee for non-accepted artists and anyone who cancels or is a no-show. This event is outdoors, rain or shine. In the event the organizers cancel, you will receive a full refund.

Juried Row First Place Award –

In addition, one award will be given to an artist who will be voted upon to have the best booth space/ best collection of artwork. This award is \$250.00 and is sponsored by the Iredell Arts Council.

General Information for Accepted Artists -

- Each artist will be given an approximate 10'x10' booth space on the grass, along the pond, at the Martin Luther King Jr. Park.
- Artists are responsible for providing ALL of their booth/tent materials, including a 10'x10' tent; tables; chairs; pedestals, racks; tablecloths; etc (No electricity/outlets are provided)
- Tents must be weighted down, with sandbags or similar weights. No exceptions.
- Artists are responsible for unloading, setting up, and breaking down their own space.
- Artists must have their own method of payment for sales (ex-cash, credit card, Venmo, etc). Artists must handle their own taxes.
- Artists keep 100% of their sales.
- Each artist will be responsible for his or her own art and art will be displayed at the artist's own risk. Each artist will be asked to sign a hold-harmless agreement.

- Payment of \$25.00 (non-refundable)
