2025 ANNUAL REPORT



2025 was a remarkable year for Mooresville Arts!

We introduced our inaugural Arts on Main weekend event, and we launched our biggest fundraising campaign to-date – the 70 for 70 annual giving campaign in commemoration of our organization’s 70th anniversary. Arts on Main was a successful venture for us, bringing in thousands of attendees to downtown Mooresville for three days of art, culture and community. Plans are in the works for the 2026 Arts on Main weekend so stay tuned. The 70 for 70 annual giving campaign not only met its fundraising goal but surpassed it for a total of \$85,000+ raised to enhance and support the mission of our growing organization.

Not only are we thankful for the success of these two initiatives, but we also have record numbers for Mooresville Arts membership – we are over 300 active members and counting! Last year, we served over 600 artists via our gallery, shop and event programs; over 400 students expanded on their skillset and learning and participated in classes and workshops with us. 70 volunteers helped support our programs, contributing 1,440+ hours. Mooresville Arts staff and its board of directors continues to grow to strengthen the organization, providing vision, direction and dedication to thriving arts programming. The growing support from our donor and sponsor base is astounding; we had nearly 500 donors and sponsors contribute to the mission and programs of Mooresville Arts in 2025. The overwhelming generosity of our donors, as well as the participation in our programming is confirmation that we are on the right path.

Looking ahead to a new year, we are excited!

Our gallery, shop and event programs will offer more opportunities to local and regional artists. Please check out our 2026 exhibit schedule if you haven’t already done so; there are show opportunities available to all fine artists. Our class/workshop schedule is stacked with many new learning opportunities, and we will continue to expand upon these offerings throughout the year.

In addition, we will be expanding our gallery hours starting in the spring of 2026; stay tuned for more information. Mooresville is growing, and we want to be able to better serve our local community and its citizens, and of course the artists’ community at-large.
