## Commissions

Mooresville Arts will retain a commission fee of 30% for members and 40% for non-members.

# **Acceptable Artwork**

## **2D Artwork**

- Framed paintings/photographs – with wire hangers (no sawtooth hangers are accepted)
- Print rack items no larger than 20" x 20" – wrapped with firm backing (mat board or foam core)
- Suggested items: original paintings and drawings, high quality prints or giclees, photography, note cards, etc.

## **3D Artwork**

Suggested items: pottery, jewelry (with displays), glass, sculpture, woodwork, fabric arts, etc.

**Note:** All artwork must be original to the artist. We will only accept artwork that is appropriate for a public art gallery, in good taste, properly prepared for display, and an acceptable size (ie. not requiring special installation or care in handling).
