Registration:

Complete the steps by Friday, April 18 by 5:00pm

- 1-Complete the online registration at mooresvillearts.org This includes paying a **non-refundable** \$25 participation fee.
- 2-Email 2 photos of your work to events@mooresvillearts.org
- *Images of work- Images that are in the range of 2MB-8MB in size must be saved with the artist's name and title of work (Example- Joe Smith.Sunshine Painting)

 *Subject line of the email- Include Your Name and Uncorked & Artsy in the subject line.

You are considered registered for the event once <u>ALL</u> of the above steps are completed. Please complete the online registration and email your photos on the same day.

*Uncorked & Artsy is a rain or shine event. Refunds will not be given to no shows or any cancellations.

Planning:

You will be assigned an approximately 10'x10' space on Main Street. **All participants will be placed on Main Street for this event!**

Please plan your booth space according to the time that is given for the event. Some participants set up a couple of tables and others may have a tent. Try to have someone come with you to help with set up and break down.

Participants are responsible for bringing:

- ~All supplies needed for set up/display (tables, chairs, display racks, lighting,etc)
- ~Method of payment for sales
- ~BATTERY powered lighting (Ex- string lights, lanterns, flashlights, etc). It will begin to get dark towards the end of the event. Electricity is not available.

^{**}Booth placement will be sent to you by Tuesday, April 29th.

~Tents are optional. If you decide to bring a tent, the size limit is 10' x 10'. <u>Tents must be weighted down.</u> No exceptions. If you do not have weights, you will be asked to remove your tent.

Check-In (4:00pm)

Check-in will begin at 4:00pm at Mooresville Arts Gallery (103 W. Center Ave). Please check-in at the gallery **before** you unload. We will ask you to sign a harmless agreement.

Unloading (4:30-5:00pm)

After you check in, unload your items on the sidewalk near your space. If a cone is in a parking space, you may move it to park and drop off your items. Place the cone back in the space after you drop off. Please **move your car off of the street immediately after unloading**. The street will close around 4:30/5:00pm and all cars should be off the street at this time.

Set Up (5:00-6:000pm)

Booth set up can begin once the street is completely clear of cars and is safe. This is typically around 4:30/5:00pm when the streets have closed. Have your booth set up by 6:00pm.

Breakdown (9:00pm-9:30pm)

Begin packing up your items at 9:00pm. Place your items on the sidewalk in preparation of picking them up. The street will reopen around 9:30pm. All of your items should be off the street by 9:30pm.
