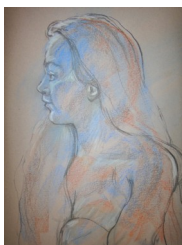

We have a signup sheet at the Depot. 10-20 people and a wait list.

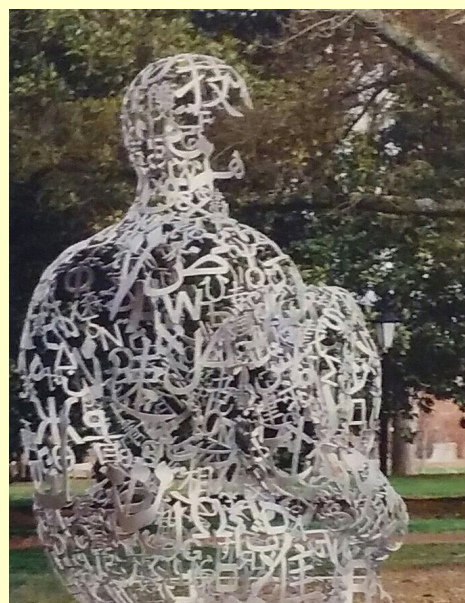
Parking for the tour is at the rear of the Belk building. We would meet in the atrium. There is no charge for the tour.
