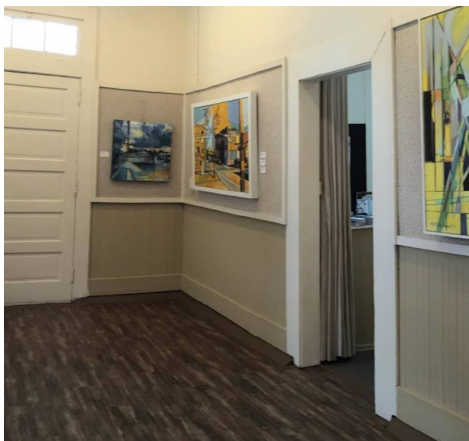

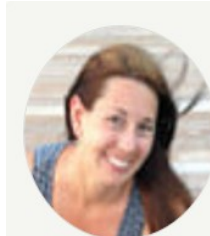


Docent's Corner

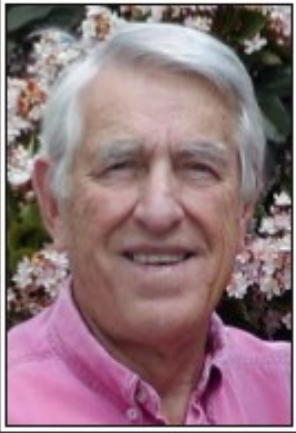
