Beginning and Intermediate Digital Photography will meet on Tuesday evenings from 7:00 until 8:30. Students may start the class with any digital camera, including a smartphone camera, but will eventually need either an interchangeable lens digital camera. We will begin with the subject of light, which is fundamental to everything else a photographer does, and progress to other aspects of composition, and work toward proficiency with the camera's manual controls. We will cover when to record in raw format and when to use jpg format, and also ethics in photography, especially regarding publishing work online and in print.
