CALENDAR:

- **Intake: Friday, January 12, 2018 from 12-4pm and Saturday, January 13 from 10-2pm.** All entries must be hand delivered to the Mooresville Arts Gallery. No entries will be accepted after 2pm on January 13, 2018.
- **Notification: Monday, January 15, 2018:** Accepted artists will be notified of entry into the juried show, by phone call or by email. *If you do not receive a phone call or email notification, please pick up your work promptly on the dates and times listed below.*
- **Tuesday, January 16, Wednesday, January 17, and Thursday, January 18:** Pick up declined work.
- **Tuesday, January 16 – Thursday, March 1, 2018:** Show Calendar/Duration.
- **Friday, January 19, 2018 from 6:00 – 8:00 pm:** Opening Reception and Awards Ceremony for exhibiting artists; family and friends are invited, as well as sponsors and the general public.
- **Friday, March 2 from 12-4 pm and Saturday, March 3 from 10am – 2pm:** REMOVAL DAYS.

*****IMPORTANT***** All artwork chosen by the Juror must remain on display for the duration of the show, and be picked up on the designated removal dates. If you are unable to arrange for your work to be picked up on the designated dates, please contact the Chairperson or Mooresville Arts to make other arrangements. Works not picked up within 30 days will become the property of Mooresville Arts.

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists **18 years of age or older** may submit up to a total of three entries. Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic, Collage, Mixed Media, Pastel, Drawing, Photography, Graphic Arts and Sculpture (of size and weight easily handled by on person) are acceptable media.

This is a juried show, so not all entries will be exhibited. The Juror will select all art to be exhibited, and the juror will choose awards. **Entrants will be notified ONLY if their work is selected for exhibition.** Those NOT notified should pick up their work on the dates indicated in the calendar section (see above). There is no theme for the show.

The work must be original in execution by the artist and in concept and composition. Work produced from published photographs, advertisements, websites, art books, other artists' work, commercial or mass-produced molds or patterns, novelty and/or decorative drafts or kit is not acceptable. Artwork created in a workshop or under the direction of an instructor is not allowed for entry. **Work should have been completed within the last three years** and not shown in ANY previous show sponsored or hosted by Mooresville Arts (included but not limited to judged, juried, members and featured artist shows).

SIZE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS:

Each entry should not exceed 48" in any direction, including frame. All hanging pieces must be dry – NO WET PAINT. Gallery wrapped canvases (with sides painted) are also acceptable. Artwork should be wired for hanging or have mounting hardware (for photographs printed on metal). NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS. ***Please have all work prepared for hanging before submission.*** Artists should be able to carry their own work into the Mooresville Arts Gallery. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to decline entries deemed inappropriate, not in good taste, works not properly prepared for display, or works that require special installation or care.

ENTRY FEE:

\$30 MA Members in good standing (limit of three works); \$45 Non-members (limit of 3 works). Membership is welcome, starting at \$45 per year. (Checks should be made out to Mooresville Artist Guild). Entry fee is non-refundable.

LIABILITY:

Mooreville Arts will do everything possible to keep each piece safe. However, submission of an entry is at the artist's own risk. Only a limited amount of insurance is provided. The declared value of the work must be reasonable and in line with the artist's previous sales. It is suggested that an artist wanting more protection insure his or her own art. (Some homeowner's policies may include protection and should be checked.)

JUROR:

Sybil Godwin – Gallery Owner at Shain Gallery in Myers Park, Charlotte, NC. Sybil recently moved back to Charlotte and has over 14 years of experience in the art world. A graduate of North Carolina State University, she moved to Atlanta, Georgia as a gallery director, returning to Charlotte in 2017 as owner of Shain Gallery, where she works with artists and clients in Charlotte and across the nation.
