CALENDAR:

- **Artwork Intake: Thursday, August 30 (12-4pm); Friday, August 31 (12-4pm); and Saturday, September 1 (10am-2pm).** All entries must be hand delivered to the Mooreville Arts Gallery. *Due to intake being on Labor Day weekend, early intake is available, but artists must notify the Show Committee ahead of time (contact info is listed below). No entries will be accepted after 2pm on Saturday, September 1, 2018.*
- **Show Calendar: Tuesday, September 4 – Thursday, September 27, 2018**
- **Opening Reception: Friday, September 14, 2018 (6-8pm)** Opening Reception for all September exhibiting artists; family and friends are invited, as well as sponsors and the community.
- **Town of Mooreville's One Moore Fest: Saturday, September 15, 2018 (4-9pm).** This exhibit for the month of September is in conjunction with *One Moore Fest*, a multicultural and international festival to be held on Broad St, in downtown Mooreville.
- **Artwork Removal: Friday, September 28, 2018 (12-4 pm) & Saturday, September 29, 2018 (10am-2pm)**

*****IMPORTANT***** All artwork must remain on display for the duration of the show and be picked up on the designated removal dates. If you are unable to arrange for your work to be picked up on the designated dates, please contact the Show Committee or Mooreville Arts to make other arrangements. Work not picked up within 30 days will become the property of Mooreville Arts.

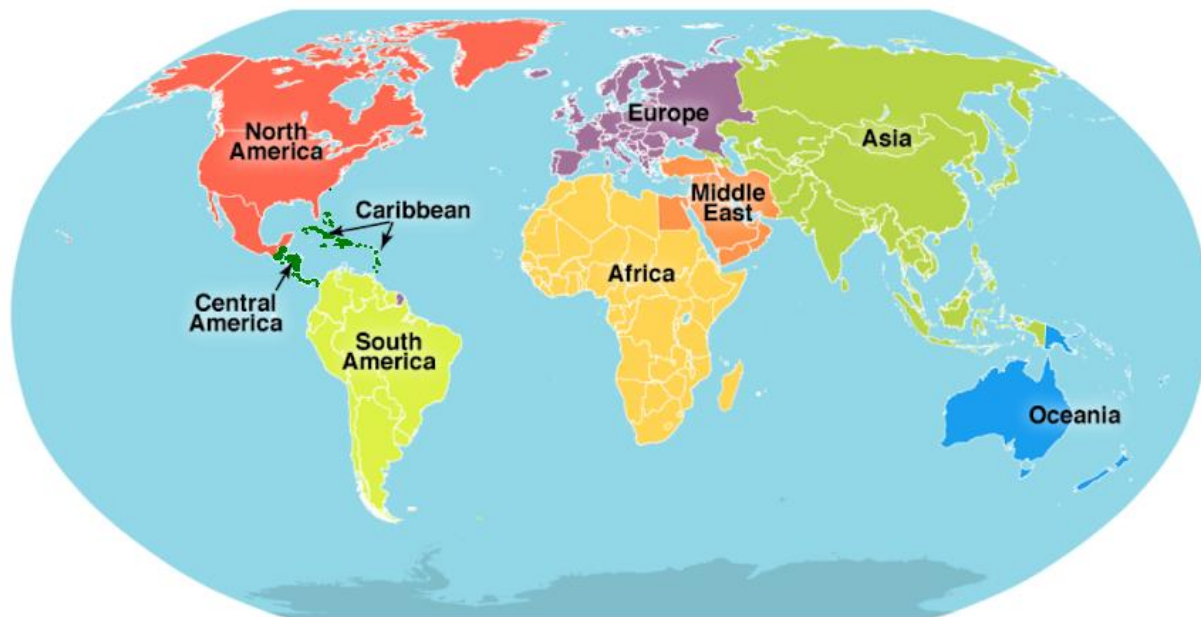
AWARDS:

3 People's Choice Awards will be announced and awarded at the conclusion of the show. The public will have the opportunity to cast their vote for their favorite piece while the show is on display. People's Choice Awards Prizes TBD.

SCOPE OF SHOW & ARTIST ELIGIBILITY:

For this multicultural themed show, artists are asked to represent their own ancestry and heritage and sign up for one of the 8 regions (map displayed just below) that will inspire his or her piece of artwork. The 8 regions are: North America; Central America & Caribbean; South America; Africa; Europe; Middle East; Asia; and, Oceania.

An artist's heritage can inspire and help create his or her artwork by the subject matter, style and/or medium the artist chooses. Artists **MUST** sign up for the region they would like, by email (contact info is listed below), as soon as possible. Each region will have five (5) spaces available for artists. Once a region is full, that region will be closed (this will be on a first-come, first served basis). ARTWORK ELIGIBILITY:

Artists **18 years of age or older** may submit ONE entry each. All media is welcome and acceptable for this show. Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic, Collage, Mixed Media, Pastel, Drawing, Photography, Graphic Arts and Sculpture (of size and weight easily handled by one person) are examples of acceptable media.

The work must be original in execution by the artist and in concept and composition. Work produced from published photographs, advertisements, websites, art books, other artists' work, commercial or mass-produced molds or patterns, novelty and/or decorative drafts or kits is not acceptable. Artwork created in a workshop or under the direction of an instructor is not allowed for entry. **Work should have been completed within the last three years** and not shown in ANY previous show sponsored or hosted by Mooresville Arts (included but not limited to judged, juried, members and featured artist shows).

SIZE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS:

Each entry should not exceed 60" in any direction, including frame. All hanging pieces must be dry – NO WET PAINT. Gallery wrapped canvases (with sides painted) are also acceptable. Artwork MUST be wired for hanging; no exceptions. NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS. ***Please have all work prepared for hanging before submission.*** Artists should be able to carry their own work into the Mooresville Arts Gallery. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to decline entries deemed inappropriate, not in good taste, works not properly prepared for display, or works that require special installation or care.

ENTRY FEE:

\$15 MA Members in good standing (limit of one work); \$20 Non-members (limit of 1 work). Membership is welcome, starting at \$45 per year. (Checks should be made out to Mooresville Artist Guild). Entry fee is non-refundable.

LIABILITY:

Mooresville Arts will do everything possible to keep each piece safe. However, submission of an entry is at the artist's own risk.

REPRODUCTION RIGHTS:

Mooresville Arts reserves the right to photograph any work for publicity or promotional purposes only. No compensation is provided for this use.

SALES:

Please note all accepted submissions to our show will be displayed in our gallery, and if so desired, are offered for sale. Mooresville Arts will assess a 30% commission for members and 40% for non-members on all work sold. No POR (Price on Request) for artwork is allowed. Mark price as NFS if you do not desire to sell.
