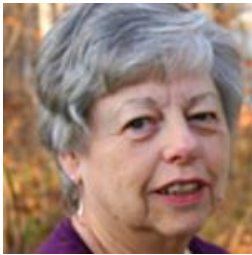

We begin with a few 5-minute poses for warm-up and then go to a long pose for the remainder of the time (giving the model breaks every 20 minutes).

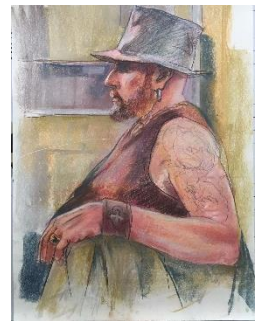
