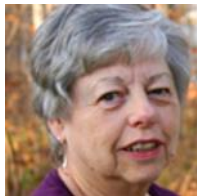

Painting with a palette knife can produce exciting or peaceful results depending on the technique. This workshop will cover those techniques to help you add texture if you want it. You can use oils (traditional or water soluble), tube acrylics or tube watercolors. Oils require Liquin medium and acrylics-acrylic gloss medium plus a slow-drying medium (watercolor can be used without mediums). Bring your supplies and pictures or set-ups and be prepared to paint from the 1st class.

sessions being a costumed theme.

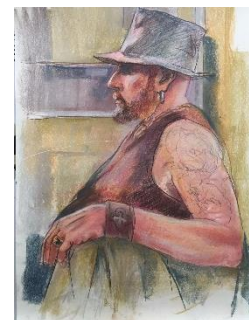
We begin with a few 5-minute poses for warm-up and then go to a long pose for the remainder of the time (giving the model breaks every 20 minutes).
