CATEGORIES:

- Oil or Acrylic Polymer, or other Two-Dimensional paint on canvas, wood or other panels that are not under glass
- Watercolor and all other water media on paper, under glass or Plexiglas
- All other Two-Dimensional Works (pencil, pastel, pen & ink, collage, print, mixed media, etc.)
- Three-Dimensional Works

*Photography and digital art will be deferred to a separate competition and should not be submitted in this show.

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists 18 years of age or older may submit up to a total of three entries. *The work must be original in execution, concept and composition by the artist. All <u>Fine Art</u> entries accepted in any medium (with the exception of photography and digital art). Work produced from widely published photographs, advertisements, websites, art books, other artists' works, commercial or mass-produced mold or patterns and artwork created in a workshop or under the direction of an instructor is not allowed for entry. Work should have been completed after April 1, 2017 and not entered in any previously judged or juried show sponsored or hosted by Mooresville Arts.*

SIZE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS:

Each 2D entry should be signed, have a title and not exceed 60" in any direction including frame. All hanging pieces must be dry— NO WET PAINT, *wired and ready for hanging* in sturdy frames. Gallery wrapped canvases are also acceptable as long as the sides are 1 ½ inches or greater and the sides are painted and/ or presentable and *wired for hanging*. NO saw tooth hangers or other hanging devices are allowed; our gallery hanging system will only accommodate hanging 2D pieces on a wire.

The maximum weight for 3D work cannot be more than 50 pounds (please contact Chairperson for further specificity on questions concerning 3D dimensions).

Please have all work prepared for hanging before submission. Artists should be able to carry their own work into the Gallery. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to limit entries deemed inappropriate, not in good taste, works not properly prepared for display, or works that require special installation or care. If your work requires special installation, be prepared with your own tools and help.

ENTRY FEE:

\$35 MA members in good standing (limit 3 works) \$50 Non-members (limit of 3 works).

Membership is welcome, starting at \$50 a year (please note increase in 2019-2020 individual membership fee). Join Us!

LIABILITY:

Mooresville Arts will do everything possible to keep each piece safe. However, submission of an entry is at the artist's own risk. The declared value of the work must be reasonable and in line with the artist's previous sales.

Lauren Harkey, a Charlotte native, earned a B.A. with distinction in Art History and Psychology from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. After graduation, Lauren interned with Carla Hanzal, the former Curator of Contemporary Art at The Mint Museum and the current Vice President of Public Art for The Arts and Science Council. Lauren earned her Masters of Letters in Modern and Contemporary Art with distinction from the University of Glasgow in association with Christie's Education in London, England, and her thesis was entitled *Common Borders: The Contingent Subject in Contemporary Art*.

Lauren graduated *cum laude* from the University of North Carolina School of Law in 2014 and is licensed to practice law in North Carolina. In law school, Lauren won a national writing competition for her art law independent study paper entitled *Copyright's Identity Crisis in the Reflection of Contemporary Art.* Since returning to Charlotte after her graduate work, Lauren has been actively involved in the arts community. Lauren currently serves as Past President of the Board of the Young Affiliates of the Mint Museum and as a member of the Craft, Design, & Fashion Collections Board of the Mint Museum. Additionally, Lauren serves on the Historic South End Board and Alumni Council of Charlotte Country Day School.
