## TEEN ART WORKSHOPS - AGES 13 – 18 (1 PM – 4 PM)

***Explore, Explore, Explore* – June 10 – 14 with Dr Mary-Louise Biasotti Hooper** – Not sure which medium is right for you? During this week, students will enjoy exploring and experimenting with a number of mediums including oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastels and colored pencil to see what inspires them!

***Painting Your World* – June 17 – 21 with Leighton Isaacs** - Students will have fun making colorful paintings of some of their favorite places using watercolor and acrylic paints. They will learn how to paint unique and beautiful scenes of mountains, deserts, forests, beaches and more! They will also learn special painting techniques they can use to create the illusion of space in their artworks.



***Exploring Another World (Photography)* – July 8 – 12 with Lisa Crates** - Students will engage in a fun week of exploration and learning how to see the world around them! They will learn how to take amazing photographs of a variety of subjects with a phone's camera, iPad, DSLR, or a point & shoot. Students will create their own amazing projects during camp and learn about subjects and techniques to do on their own after camp!

***Drawing the World with a Creative Eye* – July 15 – 19 with Dr Mary-Louise Biasotti Hooper** - Students will develop their artistic skills and creativity as they focus on seeing and studying shapes, colors, values, and lines in their everyday world. They will work on 2-dimensional projects using a variety of materials including colored pencil, pencil, chalk pastels, and oil pastels.



***Clay All the Way for Teens* – July 22 – 26 with Stephanie Gainer** - Students will use coils, slabs, pinch pots, and the wheel to create sculptural and functional hand-built works of art! Varying underglaze techniques like sgraffito, washes, monotype and/or marbling clay will be explored. Note: The type of clay and techniques used to decorate work will require a longer drying time. Therefore, masterpieces will not be ready to take home at the end of the camp session; all items will be available for pickup two weeks after the last day of camp.

## YOUTH ART CAMPS - AGES 6 – 12 (9 AM – 12 PM)

**Powerful Printmaking – June 10 – 14 with Larisa Kamp** - Draw, carve, roll, press and lift... discover the exciting art form of Printmaking! Campers will get messy and have a blast experimenting with multiple printmaking tools and techniques including monotype, collagraph, relief printing, screen printing and more. Pop art, cards and stationery, wrapping paper, t-shirts or totes... the possibilities are endless!

**Painting with the Dream Team – June 17 – 21 with Patty Acuff** – Explore the inspiring worlds of Cezanne, Monet and Van Gogh! Campers will incorporate elements of these master artists' techniques, brushstrokes, colors and blending to create their own painted masterpieces!

**Variety Is the Spice – June 24 - 28 with Leighton Isaacs-**

Experience making mixed media magic! Create new unique works of art such as paper collaging, altered books, art journaling, mixed media on canvas board, and a five-page accordion book using paint, ink, paper and other many other materials.



**Bite This! – July 8 – 12 with Cecilia Bass** - Sculptures that look good enough to eat? Using various modeling techniques with air dry clay and paper mache, campers will create tasty 3-dimensional foods such as fruits, vegetables, and baked goods!

**Learning to See Is the Key – July 15 - 19 with Cecilia Bass** - Campers will have fun exploring drawing and creativity through a guided exploration of the world around them! They will explore patterns found in nature and create their own, as well as observe and create colors they see using watercolors and oil pastels.

**Clay All the Way – July 22 - 26 with Stephanie Gainer** - In this exciting hands-on camp, campers will explore many types of clay including air dry clay, fired clay, and Sculpey clay! This year, campers will also use underglazes to learn a technique called sgraffito. This and other decorative techniques will be part of the clay experience!

**Drawing on the Right Side of the Brain – July 29 – August 2 with Patty Acuff** - Draw upside down! Draw using line only! Campers will focus on fundamental drawing skills and techniques such as proportion and developing shadows and highlights for a 3-D effect in this fun and creative camp.
