Youth Summer Art Camps are being delivered in two methods in 2020.

Due to the Covid-19 situation, Mooresville Arts is offering 2 different methods to deliver summer art camps to youth ages 6-12. Three onsite classroom camps will be held in the Mooresville Arts classroom. Extra steps are being taken to make these camps safer for students and teachers. Three other youth art camps are being offered virtually. The instructors have all taught at Mooresville Arts in the past and are experienced in teaching art virtually.

Watercolor Magic- Discover imaginative and fun ways to create original watercolor paintings! Campers will explore liquid watercolor techniques to create beautiful textures, paint realistic natural objects, water, and skies. They will learn to mix all of the colors of the rainbow and use color to express emotions and create mood in their work. Special projects include a fantastic landscape, a favorite animal or pet, and a galaxy of stars and planets!

Color Me Happy! - Discover the joy of the creative process through colorful projects and playful activities using acrylic paints! campers will explore easy and fun techniques to blend and combine colors, create faux textures and see how paint behaves on different surfaces. Projects include painting a brilliant sunset sky, using pattern to design a mandala, and a “selfie” self-portrait!

Clay All the Way - Enjoy a fun-filled week creating three-dimensional artwork from clay! Campers will get creative and get messy exploring basic clay hand building techniques using slabs, coils, and pinch pots.

Art Around the World! - Grab your passports and spend the week discovering art from global cultures! Campers will explore art styles influenced by Black History and Asian, French and Spanish cultures while working with various materials like weaving and fabrics, painting and mosaics.

Jack and the Beanstalk – Creative Book Illustration - Enter the world of Jack and the Beanstalk and Walter Crane's illustrations known as the one of the first picture books! Run in the jungle with Maurice Sendak's "Where the Wild Things Are!" Explore the worlds within illustration! Students will learn how to illustrate their own books in this camp. They will learn the points of illustrating with famous illustrators!

Sculpture 1st! - Have a ball with spheres! Take a ride with cones! Make a splash with a cylinder! Take a nature walk with a cube! Come and build a sculpture and “vibe” in 3-D!

Want to work in the industry of creating a comic book, developing cartoon characters, or illustrating creatures, props, and environments for movies? Then this is the workshop for you! Learn the techniques and skills that the professionals use in the art industry to get a head start on your dream job!

SNAP & Capture Amazing Images – Photography – Learn creative ways to use what you have (camera, phone, iPad) plus your own unique surroundings to make amazing photos to share or print! Students will discover secrets about photography and have hands on practice with lighting and editing skills to use in school, on social media, and beyond. They will explore their own environment to identify creative photographic moments and take extraordinary photos of ordinary things. Photography styles and subjects studied will include macro, fashion, portrait, event, food, water and more. This virtual workshop will include a peek inside a professional photographer’s studio.

Fashion Design - This virtual workshop offers young, inspiring fashion designers a chance to express their creative designs on several different levels. Learn how to draw the human figure, dynamic poses, faces, and hair designs for your fashion illustrations. Custom design outfits, dresses, hats, shoes, and more!

Summer Art Camps and Workshop Registration and Pricing

Registration and payment for summer art camps and workshops can be done online, by mail, or in person. A space for your son or daughter will be reserved after the registration form and payment have been received by Mooresville Arts. Once a camp or workshop is full, additional student names will be added to a wait list for that camp/workshop. Parents will be notified on a first come, first served bases if an opening occurs.

A minimum of 5 students is required to hold the summer camp or workshop. Onsite classroom maximums will be lower in 2020 at 8 students. The maximum number of students for virtual camps and workshops is 12 students.
