



In this workshop you will learn how to make canvas floorcloths and placemats with original paintings, stamps, stencil work and a combination of artistic uses for acrylic paints and sealers.

Floorcloths are heavy canvas that were decorated and used many years ago as an answer to carpeting (before commercial carpeting) for covering dirt or hard plank floors. They are a wonderful artistic addition to any home and can be made in a variety of sizes, shapes and elements.



Students will learn how to make proper edges, sewing techniques, painting techniques, and sealing requirements to make these special cloths last for many years to come. This is a technique that is as varied as it is functional.



This hands on workshop includes each student crating their own "small" cloths that can be finished in a day. Students will also learn tips and techniques, how's and why's to make floorcloths of any size.

Come, join the fun and leave with a beautiful addition for any room. The instructor will provide canvas, backing and sewing supplies, paints, stencils, stamps, sealer, and pictures. Students will need to bring brushes and any "specialty" paints they may want to use, as well as an apron, and small towel for cleanup.


