Alert the (Printing) Press! - Printmaking comes in many forms; some are one of a kind and some can be printed over and over. We will explore several different printmaking techniques including monotypes, block prints, and screen printing to create a series of designs. Students will keep their blocks and screens and can use them to print more of their designs at home as well!

Sculpture 1st! - Have a ball with spheres! Take a ride with cones! Make a splash with a cylinder! Take a nature walk with a cube! Come and build a sculpture and "vibe" in 3-D!

Thinking Outside the (Ceramic) Box - Who doesn't love a good box for all your personal treasures?! Using a combination of clay hand-building techniques, campers will create an air-dry ceramic box that is expressive and unique to each student! We'll cover pinch pot, coil, and slab construction, designing sturdy yet lightweight pottery, and then paint our creations.

I Heart CArt - Sharpen classical art skills while having FUN! Individualized, age-appropriate instruction lets young artists of all skill levels immerse themselves in a full week of drawing, painting, and creating what they LOVE!

Mini Master - Splatter, splash, swirl, glaze, smudge, paint, and draw your way through history's greatest artists and movements, step by easy step! Discover fun facts about the masters and the art movements along the way! This class will introduce campers to great art movements such as Impressionism, Expressionism, Fauvism, Cubism, and Surrealism. Let's include Contemporary and Pop Art. Get to know some great artists, such as Van Gogh, Derain, Picasso, Monet, Dali, Warhol, and others. Create your own masterpiece and become a mini master!



- **Paint in Oil!** (A Class for ALL Levels) Paint in Oil! A painting class for ALL levels will start with the basics and love the Art! Have a good time and learn to paint with oils!
- Valuable, Inside and Out Value, the spectrum from light to dark, is one of the most important elements for an artist to train their eyes to see! Students will challenge their eyes to see value by drawing with white utensils on black paper. Symbolism will come into play as we draw objects that represent the duality of our inner and outer personalities, both valuable parts of ourselves.
- Illustration: Character and Drawing Cartoons In this workshop, students will learn basic techniques in designing their own characters and different cartoon faces as well as explore the visual language of facial expressions. Students will learn how to draw a wide variety of popular cartoon characters including the Japanese style manga. They will learn how to use different tools and materials for illustrations, practice brainstorming to start the sketch, refine the sketch, ink the drawing, and apply colors to illustrate characters in a book or comic book!
- **Art Around the World** Grab your passports and spend the week discovering art from global cultures! Students will explore art styles influenced by Black History and Asian, French and Spanish cultures while working with various materials like weaving and fabrics, painting and mosaics.
- **Printmaking in the Making!** Students will be venturing through hands on experiences with different types of printmaking such as collagraphs, carved block printing, found object reliefs, dual printing and much more. Students will make unique prints and copies of their own, one-of-a-kind artwork while discovering naturistic and personal themes.
- **Drawing/The Right Side of the Brain?** Do you turn your paper upside down to draw? Can you grid? How well can you recreate an object? Find out with drawing media and gesture drawing! Practice and expand your drawing skills using different techniques, drawing media and gesture drawing!
- **SNAP & Capture Teen Photography** A creative way to use what you have (camera, phone, iPad) plus your surroundings to make amazing photos to share or print! Students will discover secrets about photography and have hands on practice with lighting and editing skills to use in school, on social media, and beyond. Photography styles and subjects studied will include macro, fashion, portrait, event, food, water and more!
