SUBMISSION PROCESS:

Entry forms and payment will be online. Artists MUST provide a digital image of their entries, as submissions will be considered and judged virtually. See below for links and instructions. Submissions must be received ahead of time by 5pm on Thursday, January 6. 2022. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

- Email digital files of your entries to gallery@mooresvillearts.org with your name, and Winter Juried Exhibit, in the subject line, ex. "John Smith Winter Juried Exhibit Submission". Please title the files accordingly- "Artist name.Title.Price", ex. "JohnSmith.Flowers.150"

CALENDAR:

- Submission Deadline: By Thursday, January 6, 2022 (by 5pm)
- Notification: Monday, January 10, 2022. Accepted artists will be notified of entry into the juried show, by phone call or by email. **If you do not receive a phone call or email notification, please do not bring in your artwork **
- Intake: Friday, January 14, 2022 from 12-4pm and Saturday, January 15, 2022 from 10am-2pm. Accepted entries must be hand delivered to the Mooresville Arts Gallery. No entries will be accepted after 2:00 pm on January 15, 2022.
- Show Calendar / Duration: Tuesday, January 18 Thursday, February 24, 2022
- Artists' Reception: Friday, January 21, 2022 (6-8pm)
- Artwork Removal: Friday, February 25 from 12-4 pm and Saturday, February 26 from 10am-2pm.

IMPORTANT All artwork chosen by the juror must remain on display for the duration of the show and be picked up on the designated removal dates. If you are unable to arrange for your work to be picked up on the designated dates, please contact Mooresville Arts to make other arrangements. Works not picked up within 30 days will become the property of Mooresville Arts.

JUROR: Adrienne Dellinger – Executive Director, Clayworks

Adrienne Dellinger is the Executive Director for Clayworks in Charlotte. Adrienne was born in Charlotte and received her Bachelor of Fine Art degree from East Carolina University. She has taught adult classes in various settings, including Clayworks and the Mint Museum of Craft + Design, and has exhibited throughout the region. She has been awarded an individual artist grant from the Arts and Science Council. Adrienne was previously an exhibiting member of the American Craft Council and Piedmont Craftsmen.

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists 18 years of age or older may submit up to a total of three entries.

Oil, watercolor, acrylic, collage, mixed media, pastel, drawing, photography, graphic arts and sculpture (of size and weight easily handled by one person) are acceptable media.

This is a juried show, so not all entries will be exhibited. The Juror will select all art to be exhibited, and the Juror will choose awards. Entrants will be notified ONLY if their work is selected for exhibition. Those NOT notified should NOT bring in their artwork during intake weekend. There is no theme for the show.

The work must be original in execution by the artist and in concept and composition. Work produced from published photographs, advertisements, websites, art books, other artists' work, commercial or mass-produced molds or patterns, novelty and/or decorative crafts or kits is not acceptable. Artwork created in a workshop or under the direction of an instructor is not allowed for entry. Work should have been completed within the last three years and not shown in ANY previous show sponsored or hosted by Mooresville Arts (including but not limited to judged, juried, members and featured artist shows).

SIZE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS:

- Each entry should not exceed 48" in any direction, including frame.
- All hanging pieces must be dry NO WET PAINT.
- Gallery wrapped 1-1/2" deep canvases (with sides painted and presentable) are also acceptable. Canvas paintings less than $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in depth MUST be framed.
- Artwork MUST be wired for hanging (NO EXCEPTIONS). For best results so that your work hangs best with our gallery hanging system, attach the back-wire hooks ¼ of the way down from the top of your painting, and leave enough slack so the wire reaches approximately 2" below the top of the work.
- Please have all work prepared for hanging before submission. Artists should be able to carry their own
 work into the Mooresville Arts Gallery. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to decline entries deemed
 inappropriate, not in good taste, works not properly prepared for display, or works that require special
 installation or care. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to use discretion in acceptance/denial of
 submitted show entries.

ENTRY FEE:

\$35 MA Members in good standing (limit of 3 works); \$50 Non-members (limit of 3 works). *Please only pay entry fee once*. Membership is welcome, starting at \$50 for individual memberships. Please visit our website at the link below for more info and to join/renew:

SALES:

Please note all accepted submissions to our show will be displayed in our galleries, and if so desired, are offered for sale. Mooresville Arts will assess a 30% commission for members and 40% for non-members on all work sold. No POR (Price on Request) for artwork is allowed. Mark price as NFS is you do not desire to sell.
