## Call for Artwork - Mooresville Public Library

INTRODUCTION- Mooresville Public Library, Mooresville, NC

Mooresville Public Library and Mooresville Arts announce a Call for Artists, to current Members of Mooresville Arts. The selected artwork will be featured, on display and for sale in the Mooresville Public Library located in Mooresville, North Carolina. The Library wishes to showcase local art and artists within the library's first floor.

Artists would be featured for four months. Paintings including mixed media, acrylic, oil, watercolor, scratchboard, and photography are all welcomed. Paintings in frames that require a protective face must have plexiglass. No glass is allowed within the frame.

### ELIGIBILITY

This call is open to current Members of Mooresville Arts.

### SCOPE OF WORK

Two-dimensional artwork is acceptable.

- Two-dimensional- Wall art that is small (11 x 14) to medium large (16 x 20 to 30 x 36 in any medium.
- Artwork should be framed and properly prepared for display; work should be wired for hanging. Frames can be minimal.
- Gallery wrapped canvases (with a depth of at least 1 1/2") with sides painted and no staples, are also acceptable.

Artwork that is accepted will be on display in various locations within the library. Artists are responsible for the delivery, the installation, and the retrieval of accepted items to and from the library in Mooresville, North Carolina.

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND CALENDAR

5-10 digital images of available work can be submitted. Do not submit images of artwork that is not available for display.

#### o DIGITAL SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Rolling Deadline, to be determined. Art will hang in place for 4 months. Submissions will be reviewed as they are received. Digital images must be submitted to Mooresville Arts at

moorevilleartsNC@gmail.com. Artists MUST include their name and Mooresville Library in the email subject line (i.e., John Smith «Library Art Submission»).

Include the following with each submission:

- Digital Image of the artwork (please include artist name and title in the image name)
- Artwork Information (artwork title, medium, artwork dimensions)
- Artist Contact Information (artist name, address, telephone number, email)

o ARTIST NOTIFICATION: Artists will receive notification if their work is accepted or not accepted for this opportunity.

o DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED ARTWORK: TBD; artists will be notified of a few options for dates and times.

## SALE OF ARTWORK

A representative of Mooresville Arts will coordinate the sale of artwork. Mooresville Arts will assess a 30% commission on any artwork sold. The library does not receive any portion of the sale of artwork. Payment to the artist will occur within 30 days of the sale.

## SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

Artwork will be selected by a representative of Mooresville Arts and/or a representative of the Library. Mooresville Arts and the Library staff reserve the right not to select any of the applicants. After initial review of digital submissions, artists may be asked to provide art in person for final selection. Artists whose work is selected for final review will be notified. If applicable, the final review will be held on a Date TBD at the Mooresville Arts location, 103 West Center Avenue, Mooresville, NC 28115.

## LIMITATIONS

Artwork with nudity, or artwork political in nature, or work deemed inappropriate or in bad taste will not be accepted.

## HOLD-HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Any artist wishing to display in this space accepts liability at his/her own risk; The Mooresville Library and Mooresville Arts will not be responsible for any damage, theft, etc. A hold harmless agreement will need to be signed by accepted artists.
