Call for Artwork – Senator Vickie Sawyer

INTRODUCTION- Senator Vickie Sawyer

Vickie Sawyer, North Carolina Senator for District 44, and Mooresville Arts announce a Call for Artists, to artists living and working in Iredell County, North Carolina. The artwork will be featured and on display in Senator Sawyer's office in the State Senate building in Raleigh, North Carolina. Senator Sawyer wishes to showcase the artistic talent in Iredell County.

Artists would be featured for three months. Paintings, photography and sculpture are all welcomed.

ELIGIBILITY

This call is open to Members of Mooresville Arts who reside in Iredell County, North Carolina.

SCOPE OF WORK

Two-dimensional and three-dimensional artwork is acceptable.

- Two-dimensional- Wall art that is medium to extra-large in size, in any medium.
- Three-dimensional- Pottery, glass, wood, metal.

Artwork should be framed and properly prepared for display; work should be wired for hanging. Frames can be minimal. Gallery wrapped canvases (with a depth of at least 1 1/2") with sides painted and no staples, are also acceptable.

Artwork that is accepted will be on display in the Senator's office. Artists are responsible for the delivery, the installation and the retrieval of accepted items to and from the office in Raleigh, North Carolina. In addition, a date and time will be designated and scheduled for artwork drop-off for accepted artists who cannot deliver their own work to Raleigh; a designated date is TBD and will be provided to the accepted artists.

LIMITATIONS

No artwork with nudity, or artwork political in nature, or work deemed inappropriate or in bad taste will be accepted.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND DEADLINE

3-5 digital images of available work can be submitted. Do not submit images of artwork that is not available for display.

Digital images must be submitted to Mooresville Arts at info@mooresvillearts.org **by 11pm EST, Friday, March 13, 2020**. Artwork submitted after 11 p.m. EST deadline will not be eligible for review. Artists MUST include their name and «Sawyer Art Submission» in the email subject line (ie John Smith «Sawyer Art Submission»).

Include the following with each submission:

- Digital Image of the artwork (please include artist name and title in the image name)
- Artwork Information (artwork title, medium, artwork dimensions, price)
- Artist Contact Information (artist name, address, telephone number, email)

SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

Artwork will be selected by a representative of Mooresville Arts and/or a representative of Senator Sawyer.

Senator Sawyer and Mooresville Arts reserve the right not to select any of the applicants.

After initial review of digital submissions, artists may be asked to provide art in person for final selection. Artists whose work is selected for final review will be notified. If applicable, the final review will be held on a Date TBD at the Mooresville Arts location, 103 West Center Avenue, Mooresville, NC 28115.
