SUBMISSION & ENTRY FEE:

Entry forms and payment will be online. We will also be asking the artists to provide a digital file of their entries. See below for links and instructions. Submissions must be received ahead of time **by 5pm on Wednesday, March 23rd, 2022.** Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted. Incomplete submissions will NOT be considered.

JUDGE:

Mary Kamerer – Artist

Mary Kamerer was born and educated in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and moved to Charlotte, North Carolina in 1987. She graduated from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and began pursuing an art career shortly after her children were grown. After studying various art forms such as stained glass, watercolor, ceramics and completing a one-year apprenticeship in goldsmithing, she concentrated on oil painting. Her style is of an impressionistic nature with liberal use of pallet knives, emphasizing light and shadows. She likes to lead the viewer to see her subjects, whether they are still lifes or landscapes, from a different perspective, sharing that moment that drew her to paint it.

ENTRY FEE:

\$35 MA members in good standing (limit 3 works) **\$50 Non-members** (limit of 3 works). Only pay entry fee ONCE.

SALES:

Please note all submissions to our show will be displayed in our galleries, and if so desired, for sale. Mooresville Arts will assess a 30% commission for members and 40% for non-members on all work sold.

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists 18 years of age or older may submit up to a total of three entries. ***The work must be original in execution, concept and composition by the artist. All Fine Art entries accepted in any medium (with the exception of photography and digital art).*** Work produced from widely published photographs, advertisements, websites, art books, other artists' works, commercial or mass-produced mold or patterns and artwork created in a workshop or under the direction of an instructor is not allowed for entry. Work should have been completed after April 1, 2020 and not entered in any previously judged or juried show sponsored or hosted by Mooresville Arts.

SIZE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS:

- Each entry should not exceed 48" in any direction, including frame. There may be some availability for pieces larger than 48"; please contact the Gallery Committee if you wish to enter work larger than 48".
- All hanging pieces must be dry – NO WET PAINT.
- Gallery wrapped 1-1/2" deep canvases (with sides painted and presentable) are also acceptable. **Canvas paintings less than 1 1/2' in depth MUST be framed.**
- Artwork MUST be wired for hanging (NO EXCEPTIONS). For best results so that your work hangs best with our gallery hanging system, attach the back-wire hook 1/4 of the way down from the top of your painting, and leave enough slack so the wire reaches approximately 2" below the top of the work.
- ***Please have all work prepared for hanging before submission.*** Artists should be able to carry their own work into the Mooresville Arts Gallery. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to decline entries deemed inappropriate, not in good taste, works not properly prepared for display, or works that require special installation or care. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to use discretion in acceptance/denial of submitted show entries.

LIABILITY:

Mooresville Arts will do everything possible to keep each piece safe. However, submission of an entry is at the artist's own risk. The declared value of the work must be reasonable and in line with the artist's previous sales.

REPRODUCTION RIGHTS:

Mooresville Arts reserves the right to photograph any work for publicity or promotional purposes only. No compensation is provided for this use.

CALENDAR:

- **ONLINE SUBMISSION: Wednesday, March 23, 2022 (by 5pm).** All entries MUST be submitted online, before intake weekend. Click on the Gallery tab via <https://moorevillearts.org> and click on the SpringFest subpage.
- **INTAKE: Friday, March 25, 2022** from 12-4pm and **Saturday March 26, 2022** from 10am-2pm. All entries must be hand delivered to the Depot Fine Arts Gallery. *No entries will be accepted after 2pm on March 26, 2022.*
- **RECEPTION: Friday, April 8, 2022** from 6-8pm: Opening Reception for exhibiting artists and awards ceremony. Artists, their families and friends are encouraged to attend. The public is also invited to attend.
- **SHOW CALENDAR: Tuesday, March 29 through Thursday, May 26, 2022.** *Please note the duration of this show has changed to a two-month long show.* Gallery hours are Tuesday-Friday from 12-4pm and Saturday 10am-2pm.
- **REMOVAL DAYS: Friday, May 27th, 2022** from 12-4pm and **Saturday, May 28th, 2022** from 10am-2pm.

*****IMPORTANT NOTE:** All works must remain on display for the duration of the show and be picked up on the designated removal dates. If you are unable to arrange for your work to be picked up on the designated dates, please contact the Chairperson or Mooresville Arts to make other arrangements. Works not picked up within 30 days will become the property of Mooresville Arts.
