

Kaleidoscope – A Juried Art Exhibit

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT FOR CONSIDERATION: Artists must submit **online by Monday, November 2nd, 2026** (see “Selection Process” section below for more info).

ARTWORK INTAKE: Friday, November 13, 2026 (12-3pm) and Saturday, November 14, 2026 (10am-1pm)

SCOPE OF EXHIBIT:

Kaleidoscope is a special juried exhibit showcasing visual art pieces, as inspired by the theme of “what is a kaleidoscope”. Artists may interpret this theme however they wish and present a finished piece of art in what the theme means personally to them.

The definition of a kaleidoscope is:

- an instrument containing loose bits of colored material (such as glass or plastic) between two flat plates and two plane mirrors so placed that changes of position of the bits of material are reflected in an endless variety of patterns
- something resembling a kaleidoscope: such as a variegated changing pattern or scene (a *kaleidoscope* of colors)
- a succession of changing phases or actions (a *kaleidoscope* of changing fashions)
- a diverse collection

ELIGIBILITY:

This call is open to Mooresville Arts Members and non-members, 18 years of age or older (eligibility may be given to some artists 16-18 years of age; please email us for details). Up to two entries per artist. ***All Fine Art entries accepted in any medium, including but not limited to: painting, drawing, mixed media, photography, digital art, ceramics, wood, glass, mosaics, sculpture, and fiber arts.***

SELECTION PROCESS:

This exhibit is a limited opportunity and **only 50 pieces will be selected for display. *This exhibit is a curated opportunity, and artists will be selected based on the quality and diversity of the artwork submitted.*** Artists should complete the online submission form – visit the Gallery tab at moorevillearts.org, click the Call for Artists subpage and follow the “kaleidoscope” prompt.

Submissions will be reviewed, and artists will be notified of acceptance/non-acceptance into the show by Monday, November 9th, 2026.

ENTRY FEE:

\$35 MA Members in good standing (limit of 2 works); \$50 Non-members (limit of 2 works). *Please only pay entry fee once.* Membership is welcome, starting at \$60 for individual memberships. Entry fee is non-refundable. NO exceptions.

SIZE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS:

- Each entry should not exceed 48" in any direction, including frame. There may be some availability for pieces larger than 36"; please contact the Gallery Committee if you wish to display work larger than 48".
- All hanging pieces must be dry – no wet paint.
- Artwork must be properly framed and/or properly prepared for presentation. Gallery wrapped (at least 1 1/2" deep) canvases with sides painted and presentable are also acceptable. Paintings on canvas or any other substrate (board, wood) less than 1 1/2" in depth MUST be framed. Artwork on metal may be acceptable without a frame.

- Artwork MUST be wired for hanging (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- The maximum weight for 3D pieces is 30 lbs.
- ***Please have all work prepared for hanging before submission.*** Artists should be able to carry their own work into the Mooresville Arts Gallery. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to decline entries deemed inappropriate, not in good taste, works not properly prepared for display, or works that require special installation or care. Mooresville Arts reserves the right to use discretion in acceptance/denial of submitted show entries.

LIABILITY:

Mooresville Arts will do everything possible to keep each piece safe. However, submission of an entry is at the artist's own risk. The declared value of the work must be reasonable and in line with the artist's previous sales.

REPRODUCTION RIGHTS:

Mooresville Arts reserves the right to photograph any work for publicity or promotional purposes only. No compensation is provided for this use.

SALES:

Please note all final pieces to our show will be displayed in our gallery and MUST be for sale (no NFS). Mooresville Arts will assess a 30% commission for members and a 40% commission for non-members. Membership is welcome, starting at \$60 a year. Join Us!

Payment to artists for any sold pieces during this show will be mailed within two weeks of the conclusion of this exhibit.

- **ARTISTS' NOTIFICATION:** By **Monday, November 9th, 2026**
- **ARTWORK INTAKE:** **Friday, November 13th (12-3pm) and Saturday, November 14th, 2026 (10am-1pm).** Only accepted artists are eligible for this exhibit. All entries must be hand delivered to the Depot. *No entries will be accepted after 1pm on November 14th, 2026.*
- **"A FIRST LOOK" TICKETED RECEPTION FOR HOLIDAY EXHIBITS:** **Friday, November 20th, from 6-8pm:** A special private and ticketed reception for "the first look" for the holiday exhibits for the 2026 Arts on Main weekend – tickets will be on sale in September of 2026.
- **SHOW CALENDAR:** **Friday, November 20th through Wednesday, December 23rd 2026.**
- **ARTWORK REMOVAL:** **Monday, January 4th, 2027 (12-3pm)**
- *****IMPORTANT NOTE:**
If you are unable to arrange for your artwork to be dropped off or picked up on the designated dates listed above, you MUST contact us (contact info below) to make other arrangements. Please do not drop off or pick up your work early without prior acknowledgment. Each exhibit is promoted through the end of each show, and many patrons visit the Gallery (and purchase) in the final week of the shows. Works not picked up within 10 days will become the property of Mooresville Arts.
