Prevention Plan:

MASKS ARE MANDATORY

Daily Temperature Screenings

- Temperature screening will occur once individuals arrive to the worksite
- >99.32 considered “at risk”; person will work alone for 1 hour and tested again, if temperature does not go down the person will be sent home

Sanitation of all shared supplies

- Computers and chairs will be sanitized after each session
- Art supplies will be assigned to individuals for the duration of the project
- Art supplies will also be sanitized between each painting session
 - Laid out to aerate for 18 hours then sanitized before use again

Frequent hand washing

- Hand sanitizer will be available at each workstation and a reliable bathroom will be predetermined on or nearest to the worksite

Contact Tracing Encouraged

- Keep track of all people present at each site each day (using check in system)
- Groups will be kept the same for the duration of the project

Distance Markers and Specific Entry/Exit Points

- Art Sites
 - 6 feet markers will be prepared around worksite when possible
 - At storm drain, individuals will wear masks and we well aerated outdoors
- GIS Workstations
 - Desks will be spaced 6 feet apart with students assigned the same seat for the duration of the project

Sick Plan:

If any member of the group is found to be sick there will be Immediate cancellation of all plans for that day and all individuals sent home

- Lots of Fish Coordinators will contact individuals within the program who has been in contact with sick individual
- Instructions will be given on how to isolate properly and sick individual will be instructed on how to notify those possibly infected

Replanning of funding use/ timelines/ future collaborations for 14 days moving forward

- Sick individual unable to return to in-person work for 14 days followed by 2 consecutive days of temp <99.32F

GIS Lesson Plan Revision

- If sickness occurs within the First week of lessons:
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- Lesson plan will be revised to allow for a Skype session with the sick individual during normal project hours alongside the in-person lesson teachings. Individual will be able to access lesson materials remotely from their computer.
- Individual will forgo the data collection portion of the lesson plan and instead acquire a classmates dataset to perform the analysis.
- The individual will complete the creation of their final product through ArcGIS Online (instead of ArcGIS Desktop which will be used in the classroom); a separate lesson plan will be provided
- **If sickness occurs after the First week of lessons:**
 - Individual will forgo the data collection portion of the lesson plan and instead acquire a classmates dataset to perform the analysis.
 - The individual will complete the creation of their final product through ArcGIS Online (instead of ArcGIS Desktop which will be used in the classroom); a separate lesson plan will be provided

Storm Drain Design Lesson Revision

- Individual will be sent a downloadable template for storm design creation and guidance for submission
- Individual will be unable to perform the physical painting of the storm drain
