ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- English language courses (ELICOS):
 - Proof of English Proficiency required.
- Vocational Education and Training (VET):
 - Qualification equivalent to Grades 10-12 in an Australian high school
 - English language proficiency of IELTS 6 or PTE 50
- Higher Education (undergraduate courses):
 - Qualification equivalent to Grade 12 in an Australian high school
 - English language proficiency of IELTS 6 or PTE 50
- Higher Education (postgraduate course):
 - Qualification equivalent to undergraduate degree
 - English language proficiency of IELTS 6.5 or PTE 58
 - Research ability or relevant work experience.

- Step 2 : Find a course
- Step 3 : Application process
- Step 4 : Letter of Offer
 - Conditional Offer
 - Unconditional Offer
- Step 5 : Course Payment
- Step 6 : Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)



STUDENT VISA REQUIREMENTS

1. Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)
2. Proof of English Proficiency
3. Proof of Sufficient Funds
4. Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)
5. Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) Requirement
6. Health Requirement
7. Biometrics
8. Character Requirement



PROOF OF SUFFICIENT FUNDS

- Total Tuition Fees for the First 12 months
(Including ELICOS Fees, if any)
- Living Cost for applicant – \$29,710
- Living Cost for spouse – \$10,394
- Living Cost for child/children (if any) – \$4,449 per child
- School Cost for school going children (if any) \$13,502 per child
- Total Travel Cost – \$2000 per person



OSHC

Overseas Student Health Cover

Cover Type	Approximate value per year
Single Cover	\$ 560
Double Cover	\$ 3,600
Family Cover	\$ 6,300



GENUINE STUDENT REQUIREMENT (GS)

Include a SOP addressing the GTE requirement in the application form

Previous study

- Academic transcripts showing qualifications achieved
- Name of the education provider(s)
- Length of study
- Certificates of attainment

Gap in previous study

- Reasons why there is a gap in your studies including where you did not maintain enrolment

Current employment and previous employment

- Your employment
- Period of employment
- Details of your position



HOW DHA ASSESSES

Situations in your home country

- Reason for not studying in your home country if a similar course is available
- Ties to your home country that support an intention to return after study is finished
- Economic situation
- Military service commitments
- Political and civil unrest in your home country

Potential situation in Australia

- Ties to Australia that present a strong incentive to stay in Australia
- Level of knowledge of the proposed course and education provider
- Previous study and qualifications
- Planned living arrangements
- Financial stability



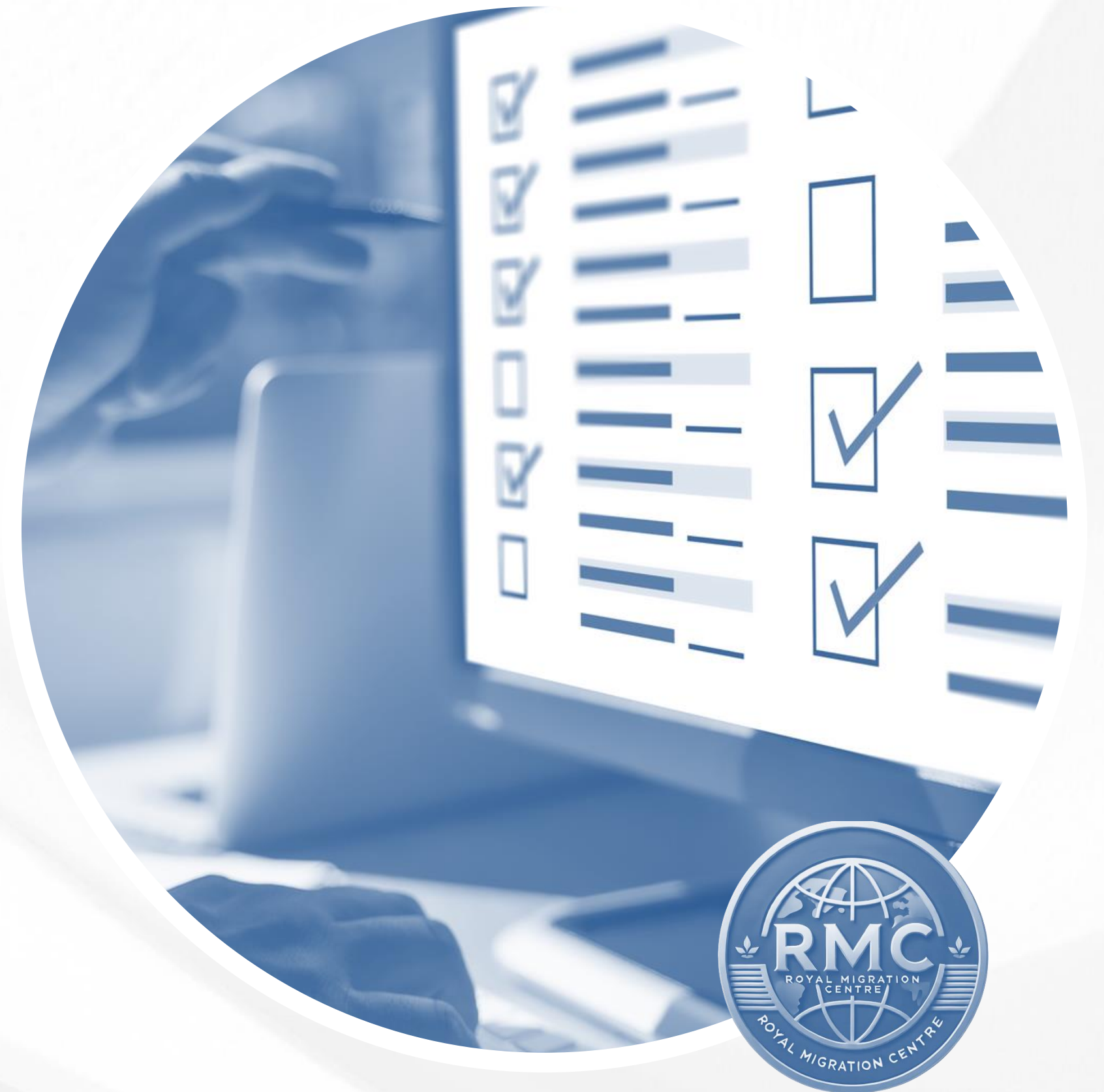
HOW DHA ASSESSES..

Value of the course to your future

- If the course is consistent with your current level of education
- If the course is relevant to past or proposed future employment in your home country or a third country
- Expected salary and other benefits in your home country or a third country obtained with your qualifications from the proposed course of study

Your immigration history

- Previous visa applications for Australia or other countries
- Visa refusals or cancellations

POST-STUDY WORK VISAS

Temporary Graduate Visa

The Temporary Graduate Visa (subclass 485) allows international graduates to work in Australia, gaining essential local experience for future residency applications.

Pathway to Permanent Residency

Post-study work rights are integral for graduates seeking permanent residency, as relevant work experience significantly strengthens their skilled migration applications.
