Edmonton is one of the few cities in Canada to have formed a non-profit Shuffleboard club. Shuffleboard play will commence in the months of May, June, July and August of 2022 at the Ottewell Curling Club (OCC), located at: 4205 - 102 Avenue, Edmonton, AB. The club's official name is: Greater Edmonton Shuffleboard Association or "GESA" for short. Participants must sign liability waiver before а participating.

Annual membership is \$55.00 per person and non-members shall be able to drop-in and shuffle for a \$5.00 daily fee (fees help offset equipment costs). Drop-in players 17 and under must be accompanied by an adult member in good standing. GESA will be offering free lessons and improvement clinics. Shuffleboard cues are provided. Recommended footwear is a rubber type runner. Never ever walk on the courts as they are very slippery and dangerous.

In floor or court shuffleboard the board is 6' wide and 39' long with a 6' shooting area at each end. Floor shuffleboard is a strategic game in which players use cues to push weighted 6"discs, sending them gliding down the narrow and elongated court, with the purpose of having them come to rest within a marked scoring area.

Shuffleboard is a sport for everyone, young and old.

It requires no great physical strength vet it is a game of skill and strategy. In shuffleboard, one tries to score, prevent the opponent from scoring, or both. Floor shuffleboard is a strategic game. The basic strategy involves both offense and defense. If it is your turn to shoot first, you are automatically on the defensive, because your opponent has the last shot of the frame. If you simply put your first shot into the scoring area, your opponent will knock it off, and if you then score with your second shot, the same will happen, and so on until you have used your last shot, and your opponent will knock that off and probably score. To combat this you can use the strategy of blocking and hiding - that is, your first shot will be a guard disk shot to a location so that it blocks your opponent from that part of the scoring area that you can still place a good disk. Your second shot will be the one to play into that hiding place you created with your first shot, so your opponent cannot hit you out directly.

Come on down, have fun, and play a game.
