

President's Message

Hi gang!

This message deals specifically with whiteboard markers and the problems we have been having erasing our scoreboards. Since we don't need all that extra work cleaning scoreboards I took it upon myself to do some research about cleaning whiteboards. This research revealed another marker brand which I then tracked down at Staples. On Saturday I went and brought some and went to the Ottewell to test them. I wrote a line of numbers with them on the scoreboard and then erased them with only the eraser and the board came perfectly clean. So on Tuesday you will find one of these laying flat on the shelf below the scoreboard. See the attached pictures and directions. Please read them and pay attention to **#2 - store** markers horizontally and **#4 - recap** when not in use (when you are not marking a score).

Lastly these markers cost \$1.91 each versus .52 cents American for the others. So please use them like the manufacturer recommends and hopefully we'll have solved our immediate problem. I feel the other markers were not working well because of the colder temperatures in the building and the different formulation of ink was not drying properly. I will test the new markers again tomorrow (Monday) as they too have had time to get cold. I'll let you know but your cooperation is appreciated and should save a lot of effort to clean the boards after a game.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Use on marker boards, glass and most non-porous surfaces. Colours may stain porous surfaces such as cloth and leather.
2. Store markers horizontally for consistent colour.
3. Do not shake.
4. Recap when not in use.
