What is Out of School Camp?

Out of School Camp is a program designed to provide care, supervision, and activities for children during times when school is not in session.

Who is eligible to enroll in the Out of School Camp?

Children ages 18 months to 12 years can enroll in the Out of School Camp. It is open to current SJLS students and students from other schools needing reliable childcare during breaks such as, Fall break.

What are the dates for Out of School Camp?

Fall Break: October 17-18

Thanksgiving Break: November 25-29
(Closed for Thanksgiving Day)

Christmas Break: December 23-31
(Closed Christmas Eve & Christmas Day)

Christmas Break Cont. : January 2-3
(Closed New Years Day)

Spring Break: March 17-21

What are the costs for enrollment and daily/weekly fees for preschool and elementary students?

There is an enrollment fee of \$50 per student. The daily rate is \$30 and the weekly rate is \$150 for preschool and elementary students. For breaks lasting a week or more, students must enroll for at least two days of camp.
