The Center for Donation & Transplant (CDT) was established in 1972 and is one of 58 federally designated non-profit organ procurement organizations in the United States. CDT serves a total of 30 counties in New York, Vermont and Massachusetts. Serving a population of 2.7 million people and in partnership with 44 hospitals, CDT's core mission is:

EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH

 CDT partners with hospitals and community organization to increase awareness on the importance and impact of donation, encouraging everyone to formally register as an organ, tissue, and eye donor.

SUPPORTING DONOR FAMILIES

 Throughout the donation process, CDT provides compassionate care and support to all donor families as they navigate the donation process. Following donation, CDT continues its support by providing aftercare services focused on family bereavement and celebrating a donor's life and legacy. Over 1,000 families are currently enrolled in CDT's aftercare program..

DELIVERING HOPE AND HEALING TO THOSE IN NEED

- Organ donation & transplantation- In 2020, 78 organ donors facilitated by CDT led to 200 lifesaving organ transplants.
- Tissue donation & transplantation- In 2020, 481 tissue donors facilitated by CDT will lead to over 35,000 lives enhanced.
