CONSERVATION TIP OF THE MONTH

Planning your vegetable garden? Did you know that vegetables are water intensive? It takes 16 gallons of water to grow a single head of lettuce!

But, mulch and compost can help!

Mulch keeps down weeds and returns organic materials to your soil, but most importantly, it can slow water evaporation!

Compost retains moisture by adding organic matter into the soil. Soil quality, as we all know, is the key to growing!

Speaking of Spring, the smaller animals that hibernate for the winter in the Northern Hemisphere usually start coming out of their burrows in April.

April is also the month that the birds migrate north and settle down for the summer to mate.
