CONSERVATION TIP OF THE MONTH

Already planning your vegetable garden, but concerned about the spike in your water bill? We've got some tips below!

Put a nozzle on your garden hose! Use a shutoff or pressure nozzle so you only use what you need when you're watering plants, cleaning the house, or washing the car.

Increase your efficiency by watering your garden in the morning or at night to reduce evaporation.
