

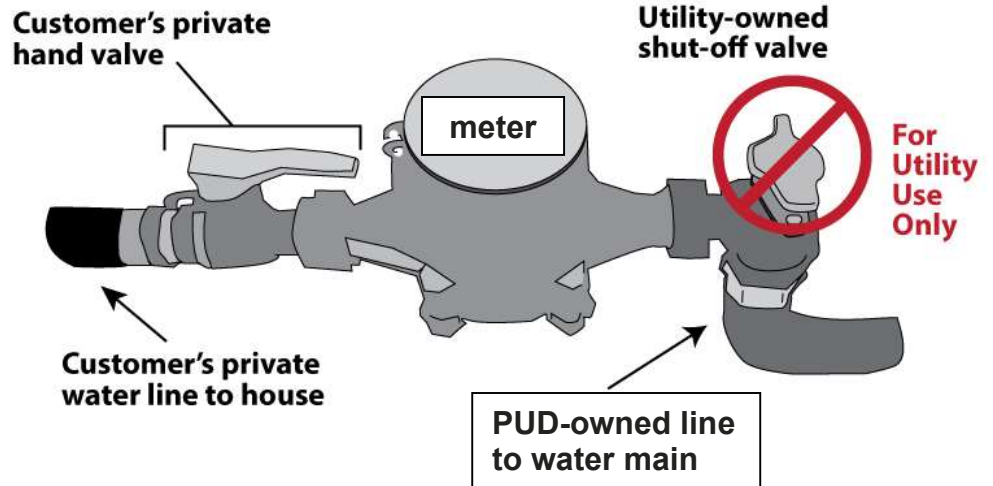


This diagram shows a typical water meter with the customer's shut-off and the PUD-owned shut off.

If you want to turn off your water because you're going out of town or working on your plumbing, please be sure to turn off YOUR side of the meter.

You are responsible for maintenance of the valve on your side of the meter. If your valve is difficult to access, we highly recommend you install a shut off valve inside your home or above ground in a valve box. If you need more info, please contact us.
