3. PERSONNEL ISSUES Settlement and Release All Claims Agreement	President Cuellar opened the discussion by referring to the "Settlement and Release All Claims Agreement" (June 24, 2025) between the PUD and Mr. Zachary Forcier. Copies had been provided to the Board members and Zach prior to the meeting. It had also been reviewed and approved by the PUD Attorney, Mr. Pete Gintner.
