BIENNIAL BUDGET MESSAGE: July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2027

This proposed budget for the 2025 - 2027 fiscal years for the Southwest Lincoln County Water District is respectfully submitted to the Southwest Lincoln County Water District Board of Commissioners and Budget Committee members. This budget reflects the anticipated annual payments for the Revenue Bond, acquired by the District in 1997.

The Water District is required to maintain a Debt Service Reserve of one annual loan payment of \$128,940 in a dedicated account. The Revenue Bond is payable from operating revenues. Since the Southwest Lincoln County Water District no longer collects revenue, funds are transferred in from the PUD entity.

Below is an estimated disbursement schedule of the annual Principal and Interest amounts, prepared by the District's auditor, Grimstad & Associates. The USDARD computes interest to the day the payment is received, which causes a variation in the amount of each installment payment that USDARD charges as interest.

After the revenue bond is paid off in 2027, the Southwest Lincoln County Water District will no longer have any liabilities. Therefore, the Water District's assets will be transferred to the Southwest Lincoln County Water People's Utility District, and, upon completion, the Water District entity will be dissolved.
