# A Note from the Executive Director Kathy Lowry

The Teller Senior Coalition (TSC) has settled into our new office space in Divide. TSC moved in January 2022 from Woodland Park. We are now closer to many of our clients and have more space to better serve seniors. We are behind McGinty's in Divide, Colorado.

TSC has a Lending Library and puzzles for seniors to enjoy. A computer is also available for seniors to use. We host Social Activities at the Pikes Peak Community Club in Divide.

We continue to assist older adults with rides to medical appointments or for other essential errands. We provide Senior Food Boxes, Home Delivered Meals, and deliver groceries to make sure no senior is without food. We maintain a Food Pantry for immediate nutrition needs. For seniors who need help cleaning their homes, we are a resource. For those caring for loved ones, we can provide a break. TSC also wants seniors to be safe in their homes and has volunteers who can install grab bars. TSC can also assist with heating needs in the colder months.

Our team of dedicated Case Managers would love to meet with you. They will recommend solutions, through TSC or other agencies, to assist with your needs. This team also makes periodic calls to check in with clients.

Last year TSC assisted 1,133 residents. We work hard to be an invaluable resource to help seniors in the community. Our team is dedicated to doing everything we can to assist older adults in the Pikes Peak region.

Many have put their routine health care needs on the back burner during COVID, and it's time to get up-to-date on your vaccinations! **Teller County Public Health & Environment (TCPHE)** offers routine vaccinations for all ages—including childhood vaccinations and those over 50



seeking the Shingles vaccine — weekly in our Divide Clinic. We can bill most insurances and do have funding sources for those who are uninsured/underinsured—making most vaccines free or low cost. We also still offer COVID vaccines and boosters.

# New Transportation Grant Funds

TSC Transit has received additional grant funds to provide transportation. On July 1<sup>st</sup> we received notice that we were awarded the Multimodal Transportation and Mitigation Options Fund grant (MMOF).

The program goals are to benefit seniors by making aging in place more feasible, benefit residents of rural and disproportionately impacted communities by providing them with more accessible and flexible public transportation services, provide enhanced mobility for persons with disabilities, and reduce emissions of air pollutants and greenhouse gases.

We will be providing additional transportation to Teller County, Eastern Park County, and Western El Paso County.
