Need To Know Info!



National Immunization Awareness Month (NIAM) is an annual observance held in August to highlight the importance of vaccination for people of all ages. NIAM was established to encourage people of all ages to make sure they are up to date on the vaccines recommended for them. Communities have continued to use the month each year to raise awareness about the important role vaccines play in preventing serious, sometimes deadly, diseases.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT SHINGLES:

In the US, currently 1 million people get shingles every year, and 1 out of every 3 people will get shingles in their lifetime.

Shingles, also known as zoster or herpes zoster, is a painful skin rash caused by the varicella zoster virus, the same virus that causes chickenpox. If you have had chickenpox, you are at risk of getting shingles.

- 1 out 3 people 60 years and older will get shingles.
- 1 out of 6 people 60 years and older who get shingles will have severe pain. The pain can last for years.
- Singles can lead to serious complications involving the eyes. Very rarely, shingles can also lead to pneumonia, hearing problems, blindness, brain inflammation, or death.

PROTECT YOURSELF AGAINST SHINGLES!

Adults 60 and older should talk to their medical professional about getting a one-time dose of the shingles vaccine.

While getting your shingles vaccine, it is a perfect time to talk to your doctor about the yearly flu vaccine, Tdap vaccine (to protect against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis -whooping cough), and Pneumococcal vaccine.
