UPDATE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Teller Senior Coalition (TSC) provides services to seniors (age 60 or over) so they can live with independence and dignity, and stay in their homes. We served 1002 clients in 2020, a 25% increase over 2019.

In 2020 TSC:

- Provided 1345 hours of case management, understanding our client's needs and providing solutions.
- Provided 5,126 door to door transportation trips, taking seniors and the general public to medical appointments, to buy groceries and for other essential purposes.
- Installed grab bars, railings and ramps for 30 clients, keeping their homes safe.
- Provided 833 hours of homemaker services, keeping homes clean and healthy.
- Delivered 9,271 meals to our homebound seniors so they had sufficient nutrition.
- Provided 1,876 hours of respite care for caregivers so they could take a break.

Due to Covid-19 we added additional services to keep seniors safe and healthy.

- Delivered 1256 bags of food, toiletries and pet food.
- Provided 610 restaurant meals as a special treat.
- Delivered 138 Holiday meals for Christmas.

- Provided 60 two-week emergency food supply boxes.
- Made 1615 Wellness phone calls to ensure seniors had what they needed and to let them know the Community cares about their well-being.

TSC can pick up and deliver prepaid prescriptions from local pharmacies. We can also pick up and deliver groceries that have been ordered online.

We are still providing residents of Teller County, Western El Paso and Eastern Park County transportation to medical appointments and other needs

We are still accepting donations of food and toiletries. Monetary donations are also appreciated and can be made through our web site or a check mailed to the Teller Senior Coalition at P.O. Box 6956, Woodland Park, Co 80866.
