Update on Teller County Census 2020

Recent information from the Census Bureau shows Teller County has only 51.3% of resident's/ household's responses to the 2020 Census vs. the State's response rate at 65.1%.*

Your response helps shape your future. Census information impacts funding for schools, roads and senior services. Census results in Colorado may direct more then \$8 Billion in federal funds to the state. Teller County's part of those funds are dependent on everyone doing the Census.

According to the Census Bureau, 100% of households have received the census questionnaire. You can fill the questionnaire out and mail it in. After that, if you still have not responded, you will be sent a reminder postcard.

If you do not respond or have a P.O. Box, when it is feasible a Census taker will visit your home.


TSC TRANSIT

Our transportation services are open. We are following CDC guidelines for social distancing and disinfection. Riders are in vehicles that allow 6-foot social distancing between drivers and riders. Masks are required for drivers and riders, drivers also wear gloves if the rider needs assistance. The drivers frequently use hand sanitizer. Our vehicles are disinfected between riders and at the end of the day. These precautions make transportation safe during the COVID19 pandemic. We are taking every precaution to assure our riders are protected. Our priority is to keep you and our drivers safe.

We will pick you up at your home for appointments and other services. Age 60+ and low-income individuals with a disability ride free, and the General Public ride for a minimal cost. Please allow 48 hours notice to schedule your ride.

Our Public Shuttle had been temporarily suspended due to the COVID19 pandemic. We resumed limited services on Wednesday, June 10th. Our Public Shuttle will run on Wednesdays.
