MEALS AND MORE FOR TELLER COUNTY SENIORS

The Teller Senior Coalition is an essential business that has remained open to serve residents age 60+ in Teller County.

Seniors are hesitant to leave their homes so our focus during this COVID-19 crisis has been ensuring our seniors have sufficient food, toiletries and food for their pets. We have delivered 456 bags containing food and toiletries to 134 residents since March. We also increased the number of seniors receiving home delivered meals.

Knowing that most of our seniors had been living on canned or frozen food, in May we began delivering hot lunches from local restaurants to give seniors something special. Plus we helped local restaurants economically survive.

We continue to pick up and deliver prepaid prescriptions or groceries ordered on-line. We are open to transport residents of Teller County and Western El Paso County, to medical appointments and for other essential needs.

Knowing that many seniors live alone without nearby relatives, we have been reaching out to seniors by phone to check on them and see what they need. We want them to know they are an important part of our community.

Even during these uncertain times, one thing you can be certain of is the Teller Senior Coalition's commitment to our senior community.

Recent information from the Census Bureau shows Teller Counties response rate is only 47.6% with the State's return rate at 62.5%.*

Your response helps shape your future. Census information impacts funding for schools, roads and senior services. Census results in Colorado may direct more then \$8 Billion in federal funds to the state. Teller County's part of those funds are dependent on everyone doing the Census.

You should have received something in your mail, if your mail does not go to a P.O. Box. If you did not respond to the mail you will receive a reminder letter and the Census questionnaire. You can fill the questionnaire out and mail in. After that, if you still have not responded, you will be sent a reminder postcard.

If you do not respond or have a P.O. Box, when it is feasible a Census taker will visit your home.

TSC TRANSIT TRANSPORTATION FOR TELLER COUNTY RESIDENTS

Our transportation services are open. We are following CDC guidelines for social distancing and disinfection. Riders are in vehicles that allow 6-foot social distancing between drivers and riders. Masks are required for drivers and riders, drivers also wear gloves if the rider needs assistance. The drivers frequently use hand sanitizer. Our vehicles are disinfected between riders and at the end of the day. These precautions make transportation safe during the COVID19 pandemic. We are taking every precaution to assure our riders are protected. Our priority is to keep you and our drivers safe.

We will pick you up at your home for appointments and other services. Age 60+ and low-income individuals with a disability ride free, and the General Public ride for a minimal cost. Please allow 48 hours notice to schedule your ride.

Our Fixed Bus Route has been temporarily suspended due to the COVID19 pandemic. We plan to resume limited services on Wednesday, June 10th. Our Fixed Bus Route will run only on Wednesdays during the month of June.

Our transportation service can also pick up your preordered, prepaid groceries and prescriptions for you and deliver them to your home.

Teller Transit is here for our seniors and community.
