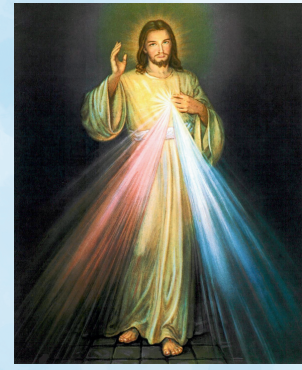




# Saint Olaf Catholic Church
