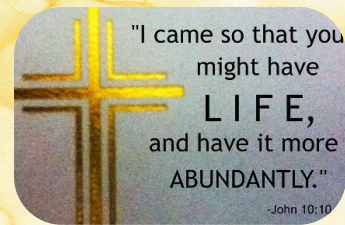




Saint Olaf Catholic Church
