Harp Meditation “The Street” On *Friday, March 20* we will have a special Lenten Harp Meditation in place of our regular Stations of the Cross at 6:00pm in the Church. Our free meatless soup dinner will follow the Harp Meditation. “The Street” is a set of 14 musical meditations on the 14 Stations of the Cross scored for solo harp. Each movement is paired with plainchant.
