

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the cost of the complete course of study? Note: with either the one or two-year course we offer licensing and/or ordination.
The complete course of study is \$900.00. In addition, each student pays \$25 per month for graduation ceremony expenses (additional information will be provided during the student onboarding session).
2. I am not ready to commit to the complete course of study may I take individual classes? If so, what is the cost?
No. CWSM is only taking graduate students this year.
3. Is there a payment plan? If so, how do I set this up?
Yes. If you prefer, you may make monthly payments of \$100 online. Reminder statements go out via email monthly.
4. Are there additional costs other than the cost of the course?
Yes. Included on the first billing statement is a one-time registration fee of \$10. Occasionally, we use textbooks from outside sources. The price is nominal, usually not more than \$15 per course. There is no outside source textbook related to the first class "Understanding the Bible."
5. How am I graded?
This is a self-study course and there are weekly assignments turned in for grading, as well as a final exam at the end of each course.
6. How will I be tested? What will the test include?
The Exam will include information learned from all components of the teaching module. A proctor from your area will administer the test and return it to us for grading. We will contact you with the results within a week of receiving your exam.
7. Will I receive a formal acknowledgement after completing a course?
Yes. Upon successful completion of a course, (determined by an exam score of 70% or higher) you will receive notification via email of your final grade.
8. Who decides on the materials used for the courses and what are their qualifications?
The decision to incorporate materials into a learning module is determined by the school Chancellor and Administrator. These individuals are both ordained in the five-fold ministry and have worked successfully in ministry for over twenty years. They are submitted to a leader (who also is on the Board of Directors) that has worked in ministry in excess of 40 years.
9. Will I have a way of contacting someone should I have questions regarding a course I am taking?
Yes. Someone will always be available to address your questions within 24 hours. You may contact us by mail, email, telephone or Internet.
10. I am not interested in taking a full bible course or class, are there other resources available for my Christian development from this ministry?
