5. BASIS OF PROPOSALS

6. PREPARATION OF PROPOSALS

- a. To be entitled to consideration, Proposals must be in compliance with the following instructions: Proposals shall be in the form which is bound with the Specifications and all blank spaces in the form shall be filled. Numbers shall be stated both in writing and in figures; in case of discrepancy, the amount shown in words shall govern; the signature shall be in longhand; and the complete form shall be without interlineations, alterations or erasures.
- b. Bid must give full firm name and address of bidder. Failure to manually sign bid will disqualify it. Person signing bid should show TITLE or AUTHORITY TO BIND HIS FIRM IN A CONTRACT.
- ~~e. Bidder must fill in the blanks with the names of subcontractors or suppliers proposed for the portions of the work listed on the bid form.~~
