The Rotary Adopt-A-Tree Project launched on Australia Day 2022, supported by a seeding grant from the National Australia Day Council.

This grant helped fund the setup of the project for the first 12 months. Through applying sound management processes a surplus from the seeding grant has occurred.

This has enabled \$10,600 to be donated to the Smith Family for Rotary Smith Family Scholarships. This amount will pay for the schooling for 17 students for 12 months! What a wonderful way to help grow our community.

Over 80 Rotary Clubs from District 9705 based in the south and west of NSW and in the ACT have signed up to help adopt more trees.


We welcome this expansion and look forward to more trees being adopted!
